## Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

**Taylor:** Several areas of expansion on the east and west side of the fire, a large intense spot fire of 157 acres near the south fork of Taylor creek. Aside from the intense heat areas the majority of the fire has scattered heat throughout.

**Grave Creek**: The only intense heat and expansion is in the Pleasant creek drainage, cooling across the remainder of the fire.

Pleasant Creek: No expansion, several heat sources throughout the perimeter area
