Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Taylor: Several areas of expansion on the east and west side of the fire, a large intense spot fire of 157 acres near the south fork of Taylor creek. Aside from the intense heat areas the majority of the fire has scattered heat throughout. Grave Creek: The only intense heat and expansion is in the Pleasant creek drainage, cooling across the remainder of the fire. Pleasant Creek: No expansion, several heat sources throughout the perimeter area
