Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Taylor: The majority of the expansion for the complex took place on the south east, west, and north flanks of the fire. Burnout operations appear to be underway in the south east side of the fire. The expansion in the northwest took place on the north side of Taylor Creek. The interior of the fire shows signs of cooling. Grave Creek: One pocket of expansion and intense heat in the south flank. The remaining fire area is showing less signs of heat than previous nights. Pleasant Creek: No expansion, several heat sources throughout the perimeter area
