<p>Grave Creek: No expansion, many isolated heat across the fire. The Southern portion of the fire has the greatest concentration of isolated heat sources tonight.</p> <p>Pleasant Creek: No expansion. A total of eleven isolated heat sources were detected, 10 in the northern portion of the fire and one at the southern end of the fire.</p> <p>King Mountain: No expansion, no heat detected.</p> <p>Spencer Creek: Fire was not flown.</p> <p>There were no potential heat sources detected tonight.</p>
