The Southern portion of the fire has the greatest concentration of isolated heat sources tonight.</p> <p><b>Pleasant Creek:</b> No expansion. A total of ten isolated heat sources were detected, 8 in the northern portion of the fire and 2 in the southern end of the fire.</p> <p><b>King Mountain:</b> No expansion, no heat detected.</p> <p><b>Spencer Creek:</b> Fire was not flown.</p> <p>There were no potential heat sources detected tonight.</p>
