## Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

**Grave Creek**: No expansion, many isolated heat sources across the fire. The Northwest and Southeast portions of the fire has the greatest concentrations of isolated heat sources tonight. There were two isolated heat sources within the 600-foot buffer on the South/Southeast end of the fire.

**Pleasant Creek:** No expansion. There were three isolated heat sources detected in the central portion of the fire, past the 600-foot buffer line towards the interior.

King Mountain: No expansion, no heat detected.

Spencer Creek: Fire was not flown.

There were no potential heat sources detected tonight.
