 Locked gate, combo
 Single lane road, no good turnaround at gate
 Creek/potential water source

Dog Prairie 5150, 5160
 Two addresses, minimum two residences/structures (visual)
 Decent clearance around one structure except for tall grass.
 Second structure has a few trees close.
 Did not get closer than gate.
 Had not picked up level two Evac notice from gate.
 Gate locked.

Grapsy Gulch 6330, 6360
 Multiple no trespassing signs.
 One lane access rd through
 timber, overgrown understory.
 Gated, dummy locked.
 Did not go to structures.
 Two addresses, minimum two
 structures expected (map).
 Unknown defensibility at this time.

Dog Prairie 5170
 Very steep drive, minimal pullouts.
 Chain across, combo lock.
 Assuming one residence (minimum one structure).
 Did not continue last chain/no trespass signs

Grapsy Gulch 6300
 Gated, locked, multiple no trespassing signs.
 Single lane drive through timber with some
 recent work done to drive.
 Creek parallels drive 50-100 off.
 Level two Evac notice still in gate.
 Minimum one structure.

16001 Wagner Creek - Fence Residence
 -Homeowner priority 1: main house
 -90 Acres total landowner property
 -landowner will set up Rainbird to be turned on if they leave
 -Water tanks combined hold 4400 gal combined
 -small pond next to woodshed 600 gal.
 -LPG Tanks within 100' below House
 -Dilapidated log outbuilding to N is NOT important
 to landowner - do not defend
 -Multiple skid roads contour below the house. Relatively clean.
 -Could be used in fire op.
 -Smaller cabin - 10 mi below house
 -Dozer line below lower cabin
 -Log decks 100-200 yds below lower cabin

16099 Wagner Cr Rd Schumaker Residence
 -30 acres timber and chaparral
 -2 story main house metal roof, cement fiberboard siding,
 stucco foundation
 -50 ft clearance
 -wood shop with open foundation underneath
 -LPG tank 100' away
 -Narrow loop driveway, 1/2 mile, limited pullouts,
 good turnarounds
 -Water tanks combine for approx 10,000 gallons
 -Ice cream
 -Lower small structure has concrete walls with cedar
 cladding, metal roof, timber within 5 feet.
 -Improvements are OK. Cut trees and brush.
 -Recommend fuel reduction on island and below main
 house and around lower house.
 -Trigger point, fire crossing alternate (PACE)
 -Recommend staging of sprinklers, pumps, foldatank
 equipment for both structures

McDonald Creek Rd Cabin
 -built in a small stand of trees in a large meadow
 with subalpine ground cover, light fuels
 -rustic cabin
 -road access for 16 engines
 -locked cable gate 1/4 mile down road
 -plenty of clearance beside timber stand.
 -Could be lit around and protected with single engine

 200 feet 1.5 hose
 Gated wye
 P cord
 2000 gal foldatank
