Repeater and base stations must be programmed with the Rx and Tx reversed.

8. MEDICAL EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

1. LINE EMERGENCY: Crew Supervisor to contact Division Supervisor with patient complaint/condition and location.

- Division Supervisor contacts:
 - Line EMT / PM
 - Communications Unit
- Communication Unit will clear command channel for emergency traffic
- Communications Unit contacts:
 - Medical Unit
 - Safety
 - Operations
- Division Supervisor will run medical emergency on command channel
- Medical Unit will:
 - Dispatch ground ambulance to nearest drop-point for ground transport only.
 - Or after patient pickup, dispatch ambulance to Heli-base for Medical AIR EVAC Flight if needed
 - Notify receiving hospital of injury status.

1. CAMP EMERGENCY: Contact Medical Unit with patient complaint/condition and location. Medical Staff will respond to stabilize incident:

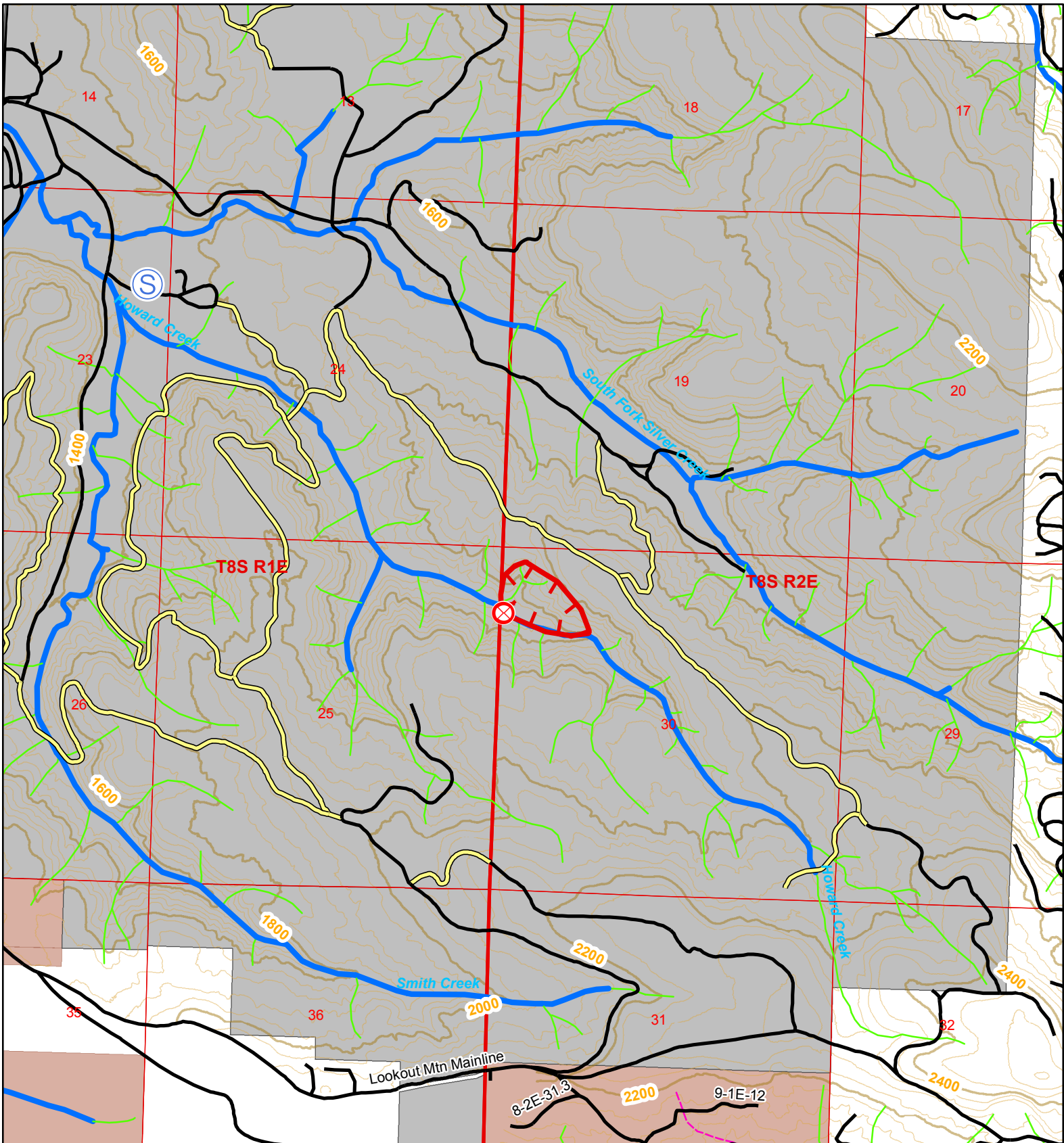

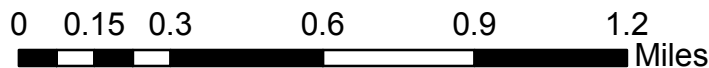
