


I started incident fire perimeter dated 08/24/2018 - . New growth for Columbus and Miles fires – 127 acres.

Yellow is 8/24/2018's incident perimeter. Red line is current IR heat perimeter.




Some growth on the southwest side of the fire in section 3.




A few isolated heat sources outside the main fire perimeter in the Cow Horn Arch area on the east side of the fire.




Scattered and isolated heat throughout the interior of the fire.
