WEATHER DISCUSSION: Weak high pressure will begin to build onto the region on Sunday and Monday. However, a couple of weak disturbances will bring a chance of showers both days. There will be a better chance of showers on Tuesday with a slightly stronger wave. High pressure will strengthen by the end of the week for a warming and drying trend that will likely last through next weekend.

**TOPICS:** 

#### **INSECT FRIENDS**

The wet and cooler weather has pushed our eight leg friends to seek warm and dry conditions within our tents. Please check your doors and seams before opening/entering your tent.

## **DRIVING/TRANSPORTATION**

Practice defensive driving skills and maintain time and distance from other vehicles and visual obstructions such as curves and blind spots. Be aware of debris fall and logs along the right-of-way. Keep your speeds low and take your time.

## **COOLER/WETTER WEATHER**

Off and on wet weather will continue though mid week. Keep your camp prepared for rain and wind. Continually evaluate road and work areas for weather impacts. Set MAP's to disengage before conditions become unsafe.

#### COMMON BARRIERS TO EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION PART 4

**Negative body language.** If you disagree with or dislike what is being said, you may use negative body language to rebuff the other person's message, such as crossing your arms, avoiding eye contact, or tapping your feet. You do not have to agree, or even like what's being said, but to communicate effectively and not make the other person defensive, it's important to avoid sending negative signals.

#### **Archie Creek and Thielsen Danger Tree Felling Specifications**


For the safety of firefighters ingress and egress to patrol and manage suppression response work on the Archie Creek Fire dead and dying trees along the identified priority roads need to be felled and removed (in some cases). The following is a draft prescription of the danger tree mitigation treatment:

- All dead trees along the prioritized roads that are at risk to hit the road need to be felled
  consistent with the Region 6 Danger Tree Identification document. Additionally, any trees with
  combinations of scorched and live crowns need to be evaluated by a person certified in danger
  tree identification for potential felling utilizing the criteria established in Smith and Cluck (2011).
- Do not cut live green trees with intact crowns.
- For tree removal, any danger tree that is felled and hits the road should be limbed and decked. Most limbs that break off within 40-75 ft of the edge of the road prism should be piled or chipped on uphill slopes adjacent to the roads.
- On steep slopes above the road, fell all danger trees within 1 ½ tree lengths. On steep slopes, where professional judgement identifies a likelihood that a tree will slide onto the road, consider removing the tree and all limbs within 40-75 ft of the road. If the tree cannot be safely pulled to the road, consider contour falling where appropriate and safe.
- For slash created by fallen trees, pile along roadsides in consultation with READs.
- Only yard trees to the road outside of riparian areas or areas where removal could cause slope erosion concerns.
- For Incense and Western Red Cedar with green needles, evaluate root scorch, if 50% or greater, consider felling for safety in consultation with READs.
- For slopes below the road, only fall dead trees that have the potential to hit the road. Only remove such trees if they hit the road and can be removed without causing resource damage.
- If for safety reasons, an area cannot be treated with danger tree felling operations, please map the area, and share it with the lead Resource Advisor for mapping purposes.

#### **Slash Specifications**

- Remove slash created by danger tree felling within 40' of edge of the road.
- Where possible, prefer to haul and chip slash rather than piling.
- Where not possible to haul, chipping into stands is preferred before piling. Don't chip to a depth greater than one foot. Where possible, shoot chips to the downhill side of the road.
- Where not possible, pile slash alongside roads in coordination with READs to avoid sensitive areas and culverts.
- When building slash piles, size is not a concern, but ensure they are at a sufficient distance from live trees to avoid killing the trees when the pile is burned.
- Cover all piles with plastic sufficiently to allow for the interior of pile to remain dry over winter.

There is a weed wash located near the Archie Creek ICP (in Glide) and at the Thielsen Spike camp.

The Archie Creek Weed Wash has MOVED.

Directions: Take 138 West into Glide, make a right (North) just West of the Glide Community Center (about 0.8 miles from Archie ICP). You'll see signs at the entrance. This is also the new Staging Area.

PLEASE wash your vehicles during the following situations:

- Prior to demob....DO NOT take our weeds home with you!
- Whenever logistically possible, wash equipment/vehicles prior to moving from the BLM/Private checkerboard to Forest Service- administered lands.

\*\*If you are just arriving to the Archie Creek or Thielsen Fire, take all vehicles through the weed wash before entering the fire areas.\*\*

To review, please wash your vehicle / equipment upon:

- 1. Initial mobilization into camp;
- 2. Final demobilization;
- 3. Moving from BLM to FS;
- 4. As often as possible!

<sup>\*</sup>Federal agencies and private industry spend thousands of dollars a year in the fight against noxious weeds as they spread from the valleys (or other infested areas) into un-infested Public Lands and plantations. Prevention is by far the most effective proactive weapon we have; it saves taxpayer dollars, and all it takes is a little extra time.







#### **EMERGENCY PLAN**

#### **INCIDENT WITHIN AN INCIDENT**

#### ON SCENE SUPERVISOR

In the event of an accident or medical incident of any size, your primary responsibility is to ENSURE that the victim(s) receive prompt and effective Triage, Treatment and Transportation.

- Conduct size-up of the incident (nature of accident, number type of resources involved, latitude and longitude location); notify incident communications center and supervisor, request assistance as needed.
- Order and coordinate medical and support response to the accident.
- Evaluate special needs (law enforcement, haz mat, etc.).
- Clear the command frequency if medical emergency; coordinate with incident communications and air attack for air medical transportation needs
- Preserve and photograph the scene for accident investigation.
- Remain aware of surroundings and the status of the main incident (delegate personnel to monitor the main fire) to ensure safety of medical treatment personnel.
- Until relieved, supervise and manage all personnel involved at the incident scene.
- ENSURE THE MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORT IN THE INCIDENT ACTION PLAN IS BEING USED AND FOLLOWED.
