# **WEATHER DISCUSSION:**

Strong high pressure will continue over the region today, with the very warm and dry conditions continuing. Little will change on Thursday with very similar conditions, but expect a little cooler temperatures on Friday into the weekend. Under strong high pressure ridging, the winds will continue to be slope driven as the winds aloft will be light through the end of the week.

Today (0600-1800):

Weather: Sunny and hot. Some upper level smoke from other fires may move into the area.

**High Temperatures:** 75-93°F. (24hr Trend: Steady°F)

**Afternoon Humidity:** 15-29%, highest on the ridges. (24hr Trend: Up 1-3%)

20 Foot Winds:

Valleys/Lower Slopes: Down slope/drainage 5 mph, becoming upslope from the south 5-10 mph late morning,

then generally from the west and up drainage 5-10 mph in the afternoon.

Upper Slopes & Ridges: South 5 mph becoming SW 5-10 G15 mph in the afternoon, then NW 5-10 mph,

with gusts 10-15 mph late afternoon into the evening.

(24hr Wind Trend: Steady)

**Transport Wind:** NW 7 mph.

LAL: 1. Chc of Wetting Rain (> or = to 0.25"): 0%Afternoon Mixing Height: 6,000ft MSL. **Inversion:** Weak at 4,000ft MSL early.

Local Thresholds for Flovated Fire Behavior- Watch Outs

20-foot winds > 13 mph RH under 25% Temperature over 85° 1,000-hour fuel moisture less than 12%.

### FIRE BEHAVIOR:

### **GENERAL:**

One- and ten-hour fuels will become receptive to ignition. One-hour fuels will range from 4% in exposed locations to 7% in sheltered locations. Ten-hour fuels will be < 9%.

Fire behavior will be **minimal** today. No active fire spread is expected. **Smoldering** in stumps, snags, and downed heavy fuels will continue. **Creeping** fire may be found in needle/leaf drop that are adjacent to the smoldering heat sources. **Running** fire may occur if fire finds its way into previously unburned pockets. Torching is possible. No fire perimeter growth is expected.

If fire starts outside containment lines expect moderate running fire with occasional torching.

ERC's are slightly above average. ERC-G is 40 at Grandad RAWS. Critical ERC level 54-58, see pocket card information below.

Rate of spread and flame lengths are model outputs based on **maximum values** for the fuel models shown, with current fuel moistures in exposed locations on steep slope.

Fuel Model	Rate of Spread	Flame Length
Grass/Shrub (GS2)	15 chains/hour 17 feet/min	6 feet
Mature Timber (TU2 & TL5)	7 chains/hour 8 feet/min	4 feet

In **one hour** a spot fire would be approximately **2 acres** in timber and **6 acres** in grass/shrub.

Probability of Ignition = **71**%

## **Specific Areas of Concern:**

### All Divisions:

Any remaining heat source near the fire line. Be aware of hidden heat sources showing up. The last few days have been favorable for small heat sources to begin to show-up. These small sources of heat have the potential to become big problems. Even the largest wildfires fires start as small embers.

**AIR OPERATIONS**: No concerns for Air Operations.

### SAFETY:

Pocket Cards provide valuable local knowledge.

The Fire Danger Pocket Card provides a format for interpreting and communicating key index values provided by the National Fire Danger Rating System. The objective is to lead to a greater awareness of fire danger and subsequently increased firefighter safety. The Pocket Card provides a description of seasonal changes in fire danger in a local area. It is useful to both local and out-of-area firefighters. The Forest Service and BLM have both produced local pocket cards.

If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.

- Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Major Hazards & Risks: Weather, Heavy Equipment, Falling Snags, Powerlines and Hunting Season.

**Weather/Hydration:** Temperatures will continue to be above average throughout the week along with lower relative humidity's. Personnel will need to monitor and increase their hydration intake throughout the day. Remember the recommended 3/1 water-to-sports drink ratios to maintain a healthy balance.

**Driving/Heavy Equipment:** Driving is one of the most hazardous tasks we do on an incident each day. As we travel to the line and throughout the workday our risk of an accident never decreases. Remain diligent by driving defensively, staying alert, adhering to posted speed limits and always being aware of your surroundings. Heavy equipment operations have specific hazards associated with them. Needs for spotters and road guards around high traffic areas are paramount to safe operations.

**Falling Snags/Felling Operations:** Hazard trees are throughout the fire area. Ensure you are safe by maintaining situational awareness, looking where you are working, and where you are parking before you engage. There will be fallers along interior roads to drop hazard trees. Fallers make sure you have road guards before felling trees along roadways.

**Powerlines:** Always treat downed powerlines as if they are LIVE wires. Refer to Powerline Safety in the (IRPG) **Incident Response Pocket Guide** pages 24 & 25.

**Hunting Season Opening Soon:** Firearms hunting season will open in Western Oregon this Saturday October 3<sup>rd</sup>. Be aware of increased activity on public lands and increased traffic trying to access areas that may still be under forest closures. Crews need to ensure public safety in any of the area's firefighters are working.

# **Deer Sightings?**

This area is home to both black-tailed deer and the Columbian white-tailed deer (CWTD), which was previously listed as a Federally Threatened species since the inauguration of the Endangered Species Act in 1978.


Back in 1994, the Columbian White-tailed deer faced an uncertain future. Their numbers had declined in the face of challenges ranging from farming, logging, and hunting to commercial and residential development.

In hopes of providing the White-tailed deer a secure habitat to rebuild their numbers, the BLM acquired 6,500 acres of grasslands and woodlands near Roseburg, Oregon. This piece of public land, managed by the Roseburg District Bureau of Land Management, U.S. Fish and Wildlife, and Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, is known as the North Bank Habitat Management Area (NBHMA), where the main objective is managing for CWTD and their habitat, along with managing for several special-status species.

The western-most contingency line for the Archie Creek fire comes down the eastern property line of the NBHMA inholding.

Columbian white-tailed deer were removed from the Endangered Species List in 2003 and ODFW has allowed controlled hunts at the NBHMA since 2006. Hunting CWTD requires a special tag from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

So, look closely if you see a deer, as it very well could be a Columbian White-tail! Distinguishing them from Black-tailed deer is a bit tricky but it is doable – the following diagram illustrates the differences;


