




WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Fog and smoke is likely to be locally dense in the morning under cloudy skies. Clouds are likely to break up today, but a limited mixing height means that it will take until late afternoon or evening for skies to become partly cloudy. It will be a few degrees warmer and RHs will begin to dry out in the afternoon. General winds will be more northwesterly, especially in the afternoon and evening. Valley fog is likely to form with cooler temperatures tonight.

Today (0600-1800):

Weather: Cloudy with isolated showers and areas of locally dense fog and smoke in the morning. Becoming mostly cloudy in the afternoon and then partly cloudy late afternoon into the evening.

High Temperatures: 62-72°F. (24hr Trend: Up 5F)

Afternoon Humidity: 48-68%, highest on the ridges. (24hr Trend: Down 15-20%)

20 Foot Winds:

Valleys/Lower Slopes: Down slope/drainage 0-10 mph, becoming up slope and up drainage 5-10 mph late morning with gusts 10-15 mph in the afternoon,

Upper Slopes & Ridges: Southwest 5-10 mph in the morning, becoming NW 5-10 mph with gusts 10-20 mph late afternoon into the evening.

(24hr Wind Trend: General winds more from the northwest in the afternoon. Little change in speed.)

Transport Wind: SW 5 mph in the morning, becoming NW 12 mph in the afternoon.

LAL: 1.

Inversion: Weak and near 2,300ft MSL early.

Chc of Wetting Rain (> or = to 0.25"): 5%

Afternoon Mixing Height: 5,000ft MSL.

Tonight (1800-0600):

Weather: Mostly clear, except for fog, locally dense, developing in the drainages below 3,000ft MSL.

Low Temperatures: 47-54°. (24hr Trend: Down 1-4F)

Overnight Max Humidity: 50-70% 2,000 to 3,000ft MSL, 70-100% elsewhere.
(24hr Trend: Down 20-40% 2,000-3,000ft MSL)

20 Foot Winds:

Lower Slopes: NW 5-10 mph with gusts 10-15 mph early evening, becoming east 5-15 mph overnight.

Upper Slopes: NW 10-15 mph with gusts 15-20 mph in the evening, becoming east 5-15 mph overnight.

LAL: 1.

Inversion: Very weak and late near 3,200ft MSL.

Chc of Wetting Rain (> OR = to 0.25"): 0%

2-5 Day Outlook, Sunday-Wednesday: Warmer and drier Sunday, then stagnating. Increased SW winds Wednesday. WNW 20ft level winds 5-15 mph Sun-Mon, becoming SE 5-10 mornings. W 5-15 mph Tue, then SW 10 G20 mph Wed. Temps 70-80 Sat w/Min RHs 35-55%. Max RHs 60-90%. Partly clouds with areas of morning fog valleys.

WEATHER SUMMARY:

Isolated rain showers this morning, good overnight humidity recoveries and higher daytime humidities with lower general wind speeds. See weather forecast in IAP for detailed forecast.

Local Thresholds – Watch Out

20-foot winds over 13 mph, RH under 25%, Temperature over 85°, 1,000-hour fuel moisture less than 12%.

FIRE BEHAVIOR:

GENERAL: The Archie Creek Fire is in the North Umpqua River drainage which includes Rock Creek. The lowest elevation is in the area of Glide, OR at 700 ft. and highest is around 4,200 ft. at Mt. Scott and other peaks further east. Terrain is the gentlest in the Glide area with 20-30% slopes and becoming much more rugged up drainage to the east with slopes 40-50%. Fuels types range from grass, oak lands in the Glide area to heavy timber to the east.

Fine Dead Fuel Moisture = 10%, 1,000 Hour Fuel Moisture = 13%, Live Fuel Moisture = 73%

ERC's are below the 90th percentile. ERC values are expected to fall below the average level due to the recent rain. However, they will quickly recover, after the rain event, due to the extended drying.

Rate of spread and flame lengths based on areas that are heavily sheltered or did not receive rain. Exposed grass and shrub fuels are very unlikely to carry fire this operational period.

New spot fires can reach 1 acres in one hour in sheltered fuels.

Probability of Ignition = 25%

Specific Areas of Concern:

SUPER-FOG formation in areas where smoke produced from smoldering fire mixes with low clouds will form quickly and result in zero visibility conditions. Likely formation below the inversion layer at 2600' msl into the early afternoon.

Branch I

Division S - The area near Emile creek and the Little River is of most concern. Smoldering in sheltered timber stands will continue, promoting potential for roll out and root falling of green trees above the 138 road.

Branch II

Division D – Isolated heat in sheltered timber above roads.

Division F&H – Rolling smoldering materials, slick roads and uncontained fire edge.

Branch III

Division H – Isolated heat in deep bottoms and sheltered timber stands.

Division N – The main area of concern is along the Panther Creek road. A fuel change due to the 2002 Apple fire will moderate fire behavior due to the higher fine fuel moistures.

AIR OPERATIONS: Sky may clear in the afternoon after inversion lifting potentially offering some opportunities for air operations.

SAFETY:

Low Visibility driving conditions due to smoke fog mix. Large areas of the fire will continue to smolder throughout the day and night in heavy duff fuels. Low atmospheric inversion layer and high humidity conditions will create favorable conditions for fog formation. When fine particulate from smoldering fires mix with water particles in the air it can diffuse light and make it very difficult to see even short distances.

Major Hazards & Risks: <i>Driving, Slides, Fatigue & Covid - 19</i>	
<p>Effects Form Last Night’s Precipitation and Potential Flash Flooding:</p> <p>The forecast last evening was for .25 inches of rain and a potential for flash flooding across the fire. If that happened it is possible for slides including rocks, trees, and soil to have slid down slopes and onto or across roads. When you drive out to your divisions this morning be sure to turn your lights on and be heads up for debris in the road. If there is dense fog and/or smoke this will exacerbate the situation.</p> <p>Another associated hazard with last evenings rain event will be slippery walking surfaces. Whether it’s climbing on your engine to adjust or retrieve equipment or walking on sloped wet surfaces be careful and avoid a bad fall.</p> <p>Fatigue:</p> <p>Definition: extreme tiredness resulting from mental or physical exertion or illness.</p> <p>Fatigue began to affect you long before you recognized it. Good food, plenty of water and changing work environments will help, but quality rest is the only effective cure. Don’t be misled by coffee, Red bull or other stimulants. You must get good rest – quality and quantity are equally important. Your decisions can hurt you and others, so sleep on it.</p> <p>COVID-19 Message:</p> <p>At this stage of the Archie Fire there are three important items that we need to focus on regarding COVID-19 mitigation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Resources need to document every day that they are self-screening (see IAP) and document any contact (see IAP) that they have outside their ‘Module of One.’ Both items need to be included with your 214. 2. Masks need to be worn when: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Resources are in confined areas both inside and outside. b. Working near other resources not in their ‘Module of One’. c. Social distancing (6’ feet of separation) is not possible. 3. People who are experiencing symptoms are reporting to Medical for evaluation.

Daily COVID-19 Reminder

- **“MODULE OF ONE” Concept:** Resources assigned to the Archie Fire need to focus on reducing the amount of time they spend around other resources they do not need to directly work with. Please limit your exposure to other resources.
- **Cloth face coverings (MASKS):** All individuals must wear a mask when they are working in close quarters outside their “Module of One.”
 - Masks must cover your mouth and nose.
 - Lightly used medical masks are okay.
 - Supply has medical masks for distribution.

Good news....the weed washes are now up and running! **Our objective is to put the fires out while minimizing damage to natural resources.** Thank you for your continued vigilance in helping us achieve that goal!

There are two weed wash locations to choose from;

- **Roseburg Fairgrounds** (regular vehicles/crummies/engines)
- **Glide** (all heavy equipment, and all vehicles)

Several of you have already been working on the line, and in that case, we ask that you **wash your vehicles during the following situations;**

- **Prior to demob! DO not take our weeds home with you!**
- **Whenever logistically possible, wash equipment/vehicles prior to moving from the BLM/Private checkerboard to Forest Service-administered lands.**

****If you are just arriving to the Archie Creek Fire, take all vehicles through the weed wash before entering the Archie Creek Fire.****

To review, **please wash your vehicle/** equipment **upon:**

- 1. Initial mobilization into camp;**
- 2. Final demobilization;**
- 3. Moving from Branch I over to Branch II and III, or from BLM to FS;**
- 4. As often as possible!**

*Reminder: all **heavy equipment** must go to **Glide** for weed washing.*

***Federal agencies and private industry spend thousands of dollars a year in the fight against noxious weeds as they spread from the valleys (or other infested areas) into un-infested Public Lands and plantations. Prevention is by far the most effective proactive weapon we have; it saves taxpayer dollars, and all it takes is a little extra time.**
