

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Cool temperatures, light east drainage winds, and areas of valley fog in the morning will give way to mostly sunny skies in the afternoon. Some high clouds will move in during the afternoon. It will be notably warmer and drier with fairly light terrain driven winds becoming WNW late in the day. Warm days Monday through Wednesday are likely to give way to a series of fronts Thursday through next weekend. Another round of wetting rainfall is likely then.

Today (0600-1800):

Weather: Mostly Clear except for areas of valley fog in the morning, then Mostly Sunny in the afternoon.

High Temperatures: 70-80°F. (24hr Trend: Up 8F)

Afternoon Humidity: 25-45%, highest on the ridges. (24hr Trend: Down 20-25%)

20 Foot Winds:

Valleys/Lower Slopes: Down slope/drainage 5-15 mph, becoming up slope and up drainage 5-10 mph late morning with gusts 10-15 mph in the afternoon,

Upper Slopes & Ridges: East 5-15 mph in the morning, becoming NW 5-10 mph with gusts 10-15 mph late afternoon into the evening.

(24hr Wind Trend: East wind up 5-10mph in the morning, then little change)

Transport Wind: E 10 mph in the morning, becoming NW 10 mph in the afternoon.

Inversion: 3,500ft MSL through late morning.

Local Thresholds – Watch Out

20-foot winds > 13 mph, RH under 25%, Temperature over 85°, **1,000-hour fuel moisture less than 12%.**

FIRE BEHAVIOR:

GENERAL:

The recent rain event and the elevated RH values have raised fine fuel moistures to a level that has greatly reduced fire behavior and the potential for new ignitions. Live fuel moistures and heavy fuels remain dry and in the critical range. These conditions will remain moderated through the early part of the week. Low to moderate fire behavior is expected today. Continued smoldering of large fuels will continue as the interior of these fuels are extremely dry.

Fine Dead Fuel Moisture = 7%, 1,000 Hour Fuel Moisture = 12%, Live Fuel Moisture = 70%
Live fuels are nearly cured and volatile. These fuels are still available despite the recent rains.

ERC's are still above average but well below the 90th percentile. ERC values are expected to remain in this range the next 5 days.

Rate of spread and flame lengths are based on maximum values for the fuel models shown, exposed fuels on steep slope.

Fuel Model	Rate of Spread	Flame Length
Grass/Shrub (GS2)	27 feet/minute	5 feet
Mature Timber (TU2 & TL5)	5-14 feet/minute	2-4 feet

New spot fires can reach 3 acres in one hour in timber stands and 20 acres in exposed grass/shrub areas.
Probability of Ignition = 55%

Specific Areas of Concern:

Branch I

Division S - The area near Emile creek and the Little River is of most concern, keeping fire from further progressing up the Emile Creek drainage towards Emile and Grotto Falls is critical. Reduced fire behavior and a shortened burn period will allow for direct line placement. Spread potential is low-moderate.

Branch II

Division E & F – The main heat is centered around the E & F division break. Favorable weather conditions will moderate any spread potential.

Branch III

Division N – The area of concern is along the Panther Creek road where fire has moved across the road in several locations.

AIR OPERATIONS: Areas of fog in the morning may hamper early air operations. No anticipated issues for Air Operations after the fog lifts.

SAFETY:

A season-ending event consists of a fire-stopping—sometimes referred to as a fire-slowng event(s)—followed by a persistent combination of environmental factors that mark the end of the fire season. An analysis was conducted using the following, the ERC drops below a relative ERC of 75% and remains below that threshold, the season-ending criteria is met.

INCIDENT: Archie Creek Wildfire	DATE: Sunday September 20, 2020
Major Hazards & Risks: Driving, Wildlife, Poison Oak, Chainsaw Operations & Covid - 19	
<p>Driving: Yesterday there were two incidents involving vehicles on our fire. Both vehicles were parked at the time they received damage. The first one involved a tree falling across the hood. The second one a private individual backed into one of our ambulances in Roseburg.</p> <p>Wildlife: There are a lot of deer and other animals crossing the roads in the early morning and evening in and around the fire area. This is especially true along the 138 Road between Roseburg and Glide. Drive defensively and use your lights. There have also been a number of bear sightings the last couple of days. Avoid leaving food along the fireline and keep your sleeping areas free of food and garbage.</p> <p>Poison Oak: There have been a number of cases of poison oak on the fire. The camps are set up with Technu, soaps, and other products to remove the urushiol resin found in poison oak, poison ivy and poison sumac plants. You will want to wash the resin off within 8 hours if possible. After 8 hours the resin has likely been absorbed in the skin. Use Technu Extreme or other product and follow up with a poison oak rash treatment like Technu Rash Relief Spray. See your Medical Unit for products to treat the poison oak.</p> <p>Chainsaw Accidents: There has been an uptick in chainsaw accidents within in Region 6 within the last couple of days. One of the incidents involved an individual getting hit by a tree during a felling operation. These accidents can become serious quickly due to the nature of the chain. Take some time to review the proper PPE requirements and felling procedures next time us have to use a chainsaw. Also make sure you have access to medical assistance and that you are comfortable and qualified to complete the task. Don’t become complacent.</p> <p>DUTY: It is our duty to do our jobs safely. Safety includes following these CDC guidelines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Wearing a Mask (where feasible)• Washing your Hands (where you can)• Maintaining Social Distancing (in briefings and around camp) <p>RESPECT: Have respect for your crew, your family and yourself by following the CDC guidelines above both on and off duty. When in the office or vehicles with your co-workers, wear a mask to respect the “Module as One”. Remember your off-duty behavior will influence the health and well-being of your crew and their families too.</p> <p>INTEGRITY: Do all of these things even when no one is watching. This way you show up for everyone in your life in the best way you can.</p>

Good news....the weed washes are now up and running! **Our objective is to put the fires out while minimizing damage to natural resources.** Thank you for your continued vigilance in helping us achieve that goal!

There are two weed wash locations to choose from;

- **Roseburg Fairgrounds** (regular vehicles/crummies/engines)
- **Glide** (all heavy equipment, and all vehicles)

Several of you have already been working on the line, and in that case, we ask that you **wash your vehicles during the following situations;**

- **Prior to demob! DO not take our weeds home with you!**
- **Whenever logistically possible, wash equipment/vehicles prior to moving from the BLM/Private checkerboard to Forest Service-administered lands.**

****If you are just arriving to the Archie Creek Fire, take all vehicles through the weed wash before entering the Archie Creek Fire.****

To review, **please wash your vehicle/** equipment **upon:**

- 1. Initial mobilization into camp;**
- 2. Final demobilization;**
- 3. Moving from Branch I over to Branch II and III, or from BLM to FS;**
- 4. As often as possible!**

*Reminder: all **heavy equipment** must go to **Glide** for weed washing.*
