 Strategic suppression objectives are to minimize acres burned on private lands and O&C lands managed by BLM. On Umpqua National Forest ownership, suppress the fire in the most efficient manner while maintaining a high probability of success protecting identified values.

2. Tactical objectives will fit with strategic objectives for land ownership and will be based on effective and timely risk management and probability of success. Base all tactics on acceptable risk commensurate with values at risk.

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Areas of low clouds and fog this morning will give way to partly cloudy skies late morning into the early afternoon. High clouds are expected to increase mid-late afternoon. Temperatures and humidity will be about that same as they were on Monday. A light southerly component to the wind in the morning will become southwesterly around midday, and then west to northwest later in the afternoon into the evening. It will be breezy Wednesday with rainfall arriving in the evening hours. Storm total rain amounts Wednesday night through Friday are likely to be 0.50 to 0.70".

Today (0600-1800):

Weather: Mostly Cloudy due to areas of fog and low clouds through mid to late morning, then Partly Cloudy. Becoming Mostly Cloudy mid to late afternoon due to high clouds.

High Temperatures: 67-77°F. (24hr Trend: Up 0-2F)

Afternoon Humidity: 30-50%, highest on the ridges. (24hr Trend: Little to no change)

POISON OAK

An itchy, red rash can be a serious problem for firefighters working in the woods. A local plant in the fire area is called Poison Oak. Their resinous sap (found in leaves, stems, and roots) contain several oils which cause an allergic reaction on the skin with itching, swelling, and painful blisters. Wildland firefighters and forestry workers particularly run the risk of exposure to these plants. Highlights:



- Employees who are *extremely sensitive* to this toxic plants need to be assigned duties that do not expose them to these plants
- Everyone should try to recognize and avoid these plants, relying not only their distinctive leaf shapes, but also on black spots on their leaves
- IvyBlock lotion or similar products can help prevent allergic reactions to the toxic compounds in these plants.
- Launder or change out nomex clothing regularly

HAZARDTREES

Snags are dead, standing trees without leaves or needles in the crowns and present a significant threat to forest worker safety. Snags may burn through more quickly than green trees and can fall without warning. *Live, structurally compromised green trees weakened by fire can also fall without notice.* Identify mitigation measures to reduce risk from hazard trees:

- Identify, communicate, establish, and monitor No-Work-Zones in all high-risk areas until the hazard has been mitigated. Assign highly qualified sawyers to mitigate
- Use heavy equipment or explosives to avoid placing sawyers under hazards.
- Plan quick and safe escape routes.
- Minimize exposure time at the stump by employing efficient felling procedures.
- Minimize impacts to the hazard tree from wedge pounding or other felling operations in the area.
- Do not turn your back on a falling tree or known hazard.
- Use lookouts to maintain secure felling areas.
- Discuss/practice medical evacuation procedures and accept risk accordingly.



Daily COVID-19 Reminder

- <u>**"MODULE OF ONE" Concept:</u>** Resources assigned to the Archie Fire need to focus on reducing the amount of time they spend around other resources they do not need to directly work with. Please limit your exposure to other resources.</u>
- <u>Cloth face coverings (MASKS)</u>: All individuals must wear a mask when they are working in close quarters outside their "Module of One."
 - Masks must cover your mouth and nose.
 - Lightly used medical masks are okay.
 - Supply has medical masks for distribution.
 - Masks need to be worn inside ICP buildings, and when social distancing is not practical (supply, ground support, briefing areas).
- <u>Hygiene:</u> All resources need to wash their hands before and after touching common items around camp.
- **Douglas County Community**: Please ensure that resources are following the above when they are visiting local area business.
- <u>Wildland Fire COVID-19 Screening Tool:</u> Apply the screening tool to yourself and any crew members you are responsible for.

Several of you have already been working on the line, and in that case, we ask that you wash your vehicles in the following situations:

- 1. Initial mobilization into camp
- 2. Final demobilization
- 3. Moving from Branch I to Branch II and III, or from BLM to FS
- 4. As often as possible

*Federal agencies and industry spend thousands of dollars a year in the fight against noxious weeds as they spread from the valleys (or other infested areas) into uninfested Public Lands and plantations. Prevention is by far the most effective and proactive weapon we have as it saves taxpayer dollars and takes little extra time to accomplish.
