WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Gusty East Winds Today

Northeast winds will then become easterly and increase this morning with gusts up to 35 mph possible this afternoon. Temperatures will continue to warm today under sunny skies. The warming and drying trend will continue on Tuesday with lower elevations climbing to around 90 degrees. The hot conditions will continue through the week and RHs will remain low with poor to moderate RH recoveries at mid and upper elevations.

Today (0600-1800):

Weather: Sunny. Winds increasing out of the east with Gusts to 35 mph possible this afternoon.

High Temperatures: 70-88°F. (24hr Trend: Up 5 to 10°F)

Afternoon Humidity: 15-30%, highest on the ridges. (24hr Trend: Down 15-20%)

IWI IC Responsibilities:

• Take charge of the scene - inform the Division Supervisor and Communications that you are the IWI IC and establish radio

communications (frequencies, channels). Identify the emergency name - (Ex. Division A medical, Fish Meadows medical, Highway 21

accident.)

• Assign or begin patient assessment Medical Incident Report (MIR) and first aid. Request additional medical resources on

division/branch or across incident. Transmit MIR patient information to Communications.

Determine patient transportation through consultation with line medical personnel and Medical Unit Leader. Consider

transportation time, risk to personnel, destination facility and available operational resources. If air transport is chosen, implement the plan for alternative transportation in the event aircraft cannot complete the mission. Order transportation resources through Communications as early as possible.

• Notify Communications as resources arrive and any patient status changes. Names of injured or deceased individuals will not be transmitted on the radio.

• Initiate documentation for future investigation; if a line safety officer is available, assign them to lead documentation. Do not move deceased individuals, gear or personal effects except to accomplish rescue work or protect the safety of others. Obtain written

documentation of witnesses. The Unit Log, ICS 214, may be used for the initial documentation, but a subsequent narrative will be required. • As appropriate, conduct an After Action Review to determine successes, areas to improve and lessons learned.

INCIDENT: Archie Creek & Thielsen FireDATE: Monday September 28, 2020Major Hazards & Risks: Easterly Winds, Heavy Equipment, Chippers & Covid - 19

Heads up for potentially strong Easterly winds this week: More so for the Archie Creek Fire than the Thielsen Fire. It was exceptionally strong easterly winds that drove the Archie Creek and other large fires in the State of Oregon in early September.

Heavy Equipment and Falling Snags:

There is a lot of heavy equipment on both of fires and likely more to come for suppression rehabilitation, road maintenance, and fuels reduction. With that brings large transports needed to move the equipment into and around the fire. This movement causes congestion and driving delays in these areas. You can help reduce the possibility of having an accident by driving slowly, alert and defensively. When you park in these areas make sure your vehicle does not block the travel way on these roads. If you are a passenger while the driver is backing offer to get out and be a spotter. These are certainly accidents that can be prevented. In addition to the heavy equipment, there will be fallers along interior roads to fell hazard trees. Fallers make sure you have road guards before felling trees along roadways.

Chippers:

There are at least 5 chipper operations on the Archie Fire and 1 on the Thielsen Fire. It is important that all resources working with the chipper be briefed on safe working practices and sign the JHA for chipper operation before using the chipper. The operator of the chipper is to be trained and qualified. That will likely be the owner or employee of the chipper contractor.

COVID-19 Message:

DUTY – It is our duty to do our jobs safely. Safety includes following these CDC guidelines:

- Wearing a Mask (where feasible)
- Washing your Hands (where you can)
- Maintaining Social Distancing (in briefings and around camp)

RESPECT – Have respect for your crew, your family and yourself by following the CDC guidelines above both on and off duty. When in the office or vehicles with your co-workers, wear a mask to respect the "Module as One". Remember your off-duty behavior will influence the health and wellbeing of your crew and their families too.

INTEGRITY – Do all these things even when no one is watching. This way you show up for everyone in your life in the best way you can.

NOXIOUS WEEDS

Noxious weeds are nonnative, invasive plant species that cause ecological and/or economical harm. Nonnative plant species can change fire regimes, form monocultures, and displace native plant communities and the wildlife that depend on those communities.

Rush skeletonweed was accidentally



introduced to the US in contaminated animal fodder in 1914. While not yet common in our area, plants often go unnoticed until infestations are large since the wiry, rush-like stems tend to blend in with grasses until the plants are in flower.

Rush skeletonweed produces dandelion-like seeds which can travel up to 20 miles in wind currents. The plants have taproots that can be up to 6.5 feet deep, and root fragments left in the soil up to four feet deep can regenerate new growth. These characters make rush skeletonweed especially difficult to control – prevention is key!



Medusahead was first introduced to the US in 1887, most likely as a hitchhiker in the fur of livestock. The plant was first recorded in our very own Roseburg, Oregon! From here, the plant spread concentrically, arriving in eastern Washington by 1901,

California by 1908, and Idaho and Nevada by the 1960s. In the rangelands of the western US, medusahead is spreading at a rate of ~ 12% a year.

Medusahead is an annual grass species capable of producing dense monocultures. In this part of Oregon, the plant is an invader in our oak and meadow systems, displacing wildlife habitat and native plants important to pollinator species.

Help prevent the spread of noxious weeds and other invaders! Wash your vehicle (especially the undercarriage) as much as possible, but at the least;

- before bringing equipment into the fire area.
- again before you demob.

Don't take our noxious weed seeds home with you!


