Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Began interpretation with 20200927 @ 2136 Wildfire Daily Fire Perimeter. Isolated and scattered heat sources detected across the incident. Seven heat sources were detected outside the perimeter (less than 150'): three in the Panther Creek drainage, one along the North Umpqua River upstream of confluence with Redman Creek, one south of the confluence of Coon Creek and Canyon Creek, one in Camp Creek drainage, and one west of the confluence of Fox Creek and North Umpqua River. No change to the perimeter was made.
