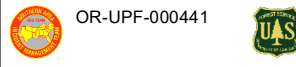


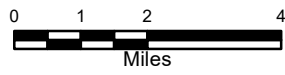
Thielsen Fire Evacuation Time Map

Estimated Ground Evac Time Overview: This layer contains the estimated ground transport time in hours from every point within the Continental United States (CONUS) to a definitive care facility (hospital). This data includes both walking speeds when traveling off-road and driving speeds according to the speed limit of the roads traveled. The intent of this layer is to initiate discussions regarding Agency Administrator risk tolerance and mitigation as it pertains to firefighter safety at the earliest possible opportunity in the decision making process. It is not intended to automatically deter resource deployment to any location, but to encourage thoughtful decisions about the risks being transferred to firefighters and how to mitigate those risks.
