Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Tonight's mapping used the previous shift's IR perimeter as a base. 39 acres of perimeter growth were mapped tonight, with intense heat along the leading edge in both the southwest and northeast portions of the fire. Multiple spot fires were located northeast of the main heat perimeter in the old burn scar. All mapped heat remains north of the Chikamin Ridge Road.
