



SAFETY EMPHASIS ON DRIVING

- ~ Practice "Defensive Driving" techniques. Road to Division A is deep powder making visibility difficult.
- ~ Honk horn to alert personnel when backing.
- ~ Keep clutter off dash and inside cab.
- ~ Follow Driving LCES (Lights, Chock blocks, Emergency brake, Seat belts.
- ~ Always use headlights.
- ~ Yield to pedestrians and bicycles.
- ~ Observe posted speed limits.
- $^{\sim}$ Use the 3 second rule for following distance when driving.
- ~ Use chock blocks, turn wheels into hill.
- ~ Avoid distractions (eating, cell phones, radio).
- ~ Ensure that windshields are kept clean of dust and bugs.
