<b>8. Weather Forecasts</b>						
<b>Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen</b>	Rain, mainly between 9am-3pm. Temperature falling to around 42 by 5pm. Breezy, with a S-SW wind 10-15 mph becoming W-SW 17-22 mph in the afternoon. Winds could gust as high as 29 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New precipitation amounts between a 0.5"-0.75" possible. <u>Tonight:</u> A 30 percent chance of rain, mainly between midnight and 4am. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 40. Breezy, with a west northwest wind 15 to 22 mph, with gusts as high as 29 mph					
<b>Lewis Co. - Centralia</b>	Rain, mainly after 10am. High near 50. S-SW wind 10 to 16 mph becoming west SW in the afternoon. Winds could gust as high as 21 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New precipitation amounts between 0.25"-1.0" possible. <u>Tonight:</u> A slight chance of rain before 8pm, then a slight chance of rain after 4am. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 35. W wind 10-16 mph, with gusts as high as 21 mph. Chance of precipitation is 20%.					
<b>Pacific Co. - Raymond</b>	Rain, mainly before 5pm. Patchy fog between 8am-9am. Snow level 3700 feet lowering to 2200 feet in the afternoon. Temperature rising to near 49 by noon, then falling to around 39 during the remainder of the day. Breezy, with a south SW wind 5-10 mph becoming SW 12-17 mph in the afternoon. Winds could gust as high as 30 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New precipitation amounts between 0.5"-0.75" possible. <u>Tonight:</u> A 50 percent chance of showers, mainly before 11pm. Snow level 1100 feet rising to 1800 feet after midnight. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 37. Breezy, with a W-NW wind 11-17 mph, with gusts as high as 30 mph. New precipitation amounts between 0.1"-0.25" possible.					
<b>Thurston Co. - Olympia</b>	Rain, mainly after 10am. High near 48. S-SW wind 8-13 mph increasing to 15-20 mph in the morning. Winds could gust as high as 25 mph. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New precipitation amounts between a 0.25"-1.0" possible. <u>Tonight:</u> A 30 percent chance of rain, mainly before 7pm. Mostly clear, with a low around 35. W-SW wind 13-16 mph, with gusts as high as 21 mph.

Based upon the average daily shots delivered in all 4 counties, the trend shows that we will reach the 80% 1st Shot goal in all 4 counties in 74 days.						
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
