Establish and maintain cost containment and cost accounting procedures in accordance with relevant guidelines.</li> <li>6. <b>8. Weather Forecasts</b>						
<b>Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen</b>	loudy through mid morning, then gradual clearing, with a high near 51. Light and variable wind becoming west 5 to 10 mph in the afternoon. <b>Tonight:</b> Increasing clouds, with a low around 43. West wind 6 to 9 mph.					
<b>Lewis Co. - Centralia</b>	Patchy fog between 8am and 9am. Otherwise, mostly sunny, with a high near 61. Calm wind becoming north northwest around 5 mph in the afternoon. <b>Tonight:</b> Increasing clouds, with a low around 37. West wind 5 to 7 mph becoming light and variable.					
<b>Pacific Co. - Raymond</b>	Patchy fog before 9am. Otherwise, cloudy, then gradually becoming mostly sunny, with a high near 56. Calm wind becoming west 5 to 7 mph in the afternoon. <b>Tonight:</b> Increasing clouds, with a low around 41. West wind 3 to 8 mph.					
<b>Thurston Co. - Olympia</b>	Mostly sunny, with a high near 60. Calm wind becoming north around 5 mph in the afternoon. <b>Tonight:</b> Increasing clouds, with a low around 38. Calm wind becoming southwest around 6 mph after midnight.
