<b>Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen</b>	Sunny, with a high near 58. East northeast wind 5 to 7 mph becoming light and variable in the afternoon. <u>Tonight:</u> Clear, with a low around 43. East wind 5 to 8 mph.			
<b>Lewis Co. - Centralia</b>	Areas of frost before 8am. Otherwise, sunny, with a high near 62. Wind chill values between 24 and 34 early. North wind 7 to 10 mph. <u>Tonight:</u> Clear, with a low around 37. North northeast wind 6 to 13 mph.			
<b>Pacific Co. - Raymond</b>	Patchy frost before 7am. Otherwise, sunny, with a high near 61. Northeast wind 5 to 10 mph. <u>Tonight:</u> Clear, with a low around 35. North northeast wind 6 to 9 mph.			
<b>Thurston Co. - Olympia</b>	Areas of frost before 8am. Otherwise, sunny, with a high near 61. Light and variable wind becoming north northeast 6 to 11 mph in the morning. <u>Tonight:</u> Clear, with a low around 38. North northeast wind 9 to 13 mph.
