<b>Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen</b>	Shows likely, mainly before 2pm. Cloudy, with a high near 51. South wind 8 to 11 mph becoming west in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New precipitation amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch possible. <u>Tonight:</u> A 40 percent chance of showers. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 45. West wind 5 to 9 mph becoming calm in the evening.
