Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen	A 30 percent chance of showers, mainly between 8am and 11am. Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming sunny, with a high near 52. Light and variable wind becoming west 5 to 10 mph in the morning. <u>Monday Night:</u> Partly cloudy, with a low around 44. West wind 5 to 8 mph becoming calm in the evening.													
Lewis Co. - Centralia	A 30 percent chance of showers, mainly after 11am. Partly sunny, with a high near 59. Calm wind becoming southwest around 6 mph in the afternoon. <u>Monday Night:</u> Partly cloudy, with a low around 39. West wind around 6 mph becoming calm after midnight.
