<b>Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen</b>	Mostly cloudy through mid morning, then gradual clearing, with a high near 56. Light west wind increasing to 6 to 11 mph in the morning. <u>Tonight:</u> Increasing clouds, with a low around 45. West wind 5 to 8 mph becoming calm.					
<b>Lewis Co. - Centralia</b>	Cloudy through mid morning, then gradual clearing, with a high near 67. Calm wind becoming northwest 5 to 7 mph in the afternoon. <u>Tonight:</u> Partly cloudy, with a low around 40. Northwest wind 5 to 8 mph becoming calm in the evening.
