<b>Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen</b>	Rain likely. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 51. South southeast wind around 8 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. New precipitation amounts of less than a tenth of an inch possible. <u>Tonight:</u> A 30 percent chance of rain, mainly before 11pm. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 47. West wind 5 to 9 mph becoming calm after midnight.					
<b>Lewis Co. - Centralia</b>	A 40 percent chance of rain. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 54. South wind around 9 mph. <u>Tonight:</u> A 30 percent chance of rain, mainly before 11pm. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 42. South southeast wind 5 to 8 mph becoming southwest in the evening.					
<b>Pacific Co. - Raymond</b>	Rain likely, mainly between 4pm and 5pm. Mostly cloudy, with a steady temperature around 53. South southwest wind around 5 mph. Chance of precipitation is 60%. <u>Tonight:</u> A 30 percent chance of rain, mainly before 7pm. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 45. West wind 5 to 7 mph becoming calm in the evening.
