<b>Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen</b>	Partly sunny, then gradually becoming sunny, with a high near 65. Light and variable wind becoming west southwest 5 to 10 mph in the afternoon. <u>Tonight:</u> Increasing clouds, with a low around 50. West wind 5 to 9 mph becoming calm after midnight.						
<b>Lewis Co. - Centralia</b>	Mostly sunny, with a high near 73. Light northwest wind increasing to 5 to 10 mph in the afternoon. <u>Tonight:</u> Mostly clear, with a low around 45. West northwest wind 8 to 13 mph becoming light after midnight.						
<b>Pacific Co. - Raymond</b>	Patchy fog before 8am. Otherwise, cloudy through mid morning, then gradual clearing, with a high near 71. Calm wind becoming west northwest 5 to 8 mph in the afternoon. <u>Tonight:</u> Increasing clouds, with a low around 46. West northwest wind 5 to 9 mph becoming calm after midnight.
