Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen	Showers likely, mainly before 11am. Cloudy, then gradually becoming mostly sunny, with a high near 51. West wind 5 to 11 mph. Chance of precipitation is 70%. New precipitation amounts of less than a tenth of an inch possible. <u>Tonight:</u> A 30 percent chance of showers, mainly before 11pm. Partly cloudy, with a low around 41. West wind 5 to 10 mph becoming light and variable after midnight.			
Lewis Co. - Centralia	Showers, with thunderstorms also possible after 11am. High near 59. South wind 8 to 14 mph becoming west in the afternoon. Winds could gust as high as 20 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%. New rainfall amounts of less than a tenth of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms. <u>Tonight:</u> A 30 percent chance of showers before 11pm. Partly cloudy, with a low around 36. West northwest wind 6 to 11 mph becoming light and variable after midnight.			
Pacific Co. - Raymond	Showers likely. Partly sunny, with a high near 55. West southwest wind 6 to 9 mph. Chance of precipitation is 70%. New precipitation amounts of less than a tenth of an inch possible. <u>Tonight:</u> A 30 percent chance of showers before 11pm. Patchy fog after 11pm. Otherwise, mostly cloudy, with a low around 39. West wind 5 to 9 mph becoming calm in the evening.			
Thurston Co. - Olympia	Showers likely, then showers and possibly a thunderstorm after 11am. High near 58. Southwest wind 9 to 11 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%. New rainfall amounts of less than a tenth of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms. <u>Tonight:</u> A 40 percent chance of showers before 11pm. Partly cloudy, with a low around 37. West wind 8 to 13 mph becoming light and variable after midnight.
