<b>Grays Harbor Co. - Aberdeen</b>	A 20 percent chance of showers before 8am. Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming sunny, with a high near 55. West wind 8 to 11 mph. Friday Night: Increasing clouds, with a low around 45. West wind 6 to 11 mph becoming light and variable in the evening.			
<b>Lewis Co. - Centralia</b>	A 20 percent chance of showers before 8am. Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming sunny, with a high near 66. West wind 5 to 7 mph. Friday Night: Increasing clouds, with a low around 42. West northwest wind 5 to 8 mph.			
<b>Pacific Co. - Raymond</b>	Isolated showers before noon. Patchy fog before 8am. Otherwise, mostly sunny, with a high near 62. Light west southwest wind becoming west 5 to 10 mph in the morning. Chance of precipitation is 20%. Friday Night: Patchy fog after 11pm. Otherwise, increasing clouds, with a low around 42. West wind 5 to 10 mph becoming light and variable in the evening.			
<b>Thurston Co. - Olympia</b>	A 20 percent chance of showers before 8am. Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming sunny, with a high near 64. West southwest wind 6 to 9 mph. Friday Night: Mostly clear, with a low around 43. West northwest wind around 7 mph becoming north northeast after midnight.
