3. Leaders Intent Continue to coordinate and support the Department of Health and West Region system planning and critical organizational needs. Meetings are scheduled between the IMO and represented counties in the West Region to plan to support mass vaccination functions. Invitations to ongoing County meetings are in place to further develop safety, operational, logistical, and financial needs. Ongoing research into ordering avenues for each county, as well as the state, to meet needs as each vaccination location expands to incorporate mass vaccination.		
4. Incident Objectives <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide for the health, safety, and welfare of all public safety personnel, healthcare providers, clinic attendees, and vaccine recipients. ● Develop plans to implement mass vaccination clinics for West Region residents in accordance with needs identified by the Counties. ● Coordinate delivery of vaccines in accordance with relevant eligibility schedules. ● Coordinate documentation of vaccines delivered. ● Establish and maintain cost containment and cost accounting procedures in accordance with relevant guidelines. ● Coordinate with LHJs for the timely, coordinated release of accurate public information. ● Maintain and enhance interagency and interdisciplinary relationships by developing and maintaining an environment in which all participants are treated with dignity and respect. 		
5. Weather <u>Aberdeen, Grays Harbor Co:</u> A 30 percent chance of rain before 11am. Mostly cloudy, then gradually becoming sunny, with a high near 46. West northwest wind 15 to 17 mph, with gusts as high as 22 mph. <u>Saturday Night</u> Mostly clear, with a low around 35. North northwest wind 11 to 16 mph decreasing to 5 to 10 mph after midnight. Winds could gust as high as 21 mph. <u>Sunday</u> Sunny, with a high near 51. North northwest wind 3 to 6 mph. <u>Sunday Night</u> Clear, with a low around 35. <u>Monday</u> Sunny, with a high near 57. <u>Monday Night</u> Mostly clear, with a low around 41. <u>Centralia, Lewis Co:</u> A 40 percent chance of rain, mainly before 11am. Partly sunny, with a high near 50. West wind 8 to 13 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph. <u>Saturday Night</u> Widespread frost, mainly after midnight. Otherwise, mostly clear, with a low around 28. West wind 6 to 11 mph becoming light west southwest in the evening. Winds could gust as high as 21 mph. <u>Sunday</u> Widespread frost, mainly before 9am. Otherwise, sunny, with a high near 56. Calm wind becoming north northeast around 6 mph in the afternoon. <u>Sunday Night</u> Clear, with a low around 32. <u>Monday</u> Sunny, with a high near 63. <u>Monday Night</u> Clear, with a low around 34.		

Olympia, Thurston Co:

A 40 percent chance of rain. Partly sunny, with a high near 50. Southwest wind 9 to 13 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph. Saturday Night Widespread frost, mainly after 2am. Otherwise, partly cloudy, with a low around 29. West wind 8 to 13 mph becoming light and variable in the evening. Sunday Widespread frost, mainly before 9am. Otherwise, sunny, with a high near 54. Calm wind becoming north northeast 5 to 7 mph in the afternoon. Sunday Night Clear, with a low around 33. Monday Sunny, with a high near 61. Monday Night Clear, with a low around 36.

Raymond, Pacific Co:

A chance of rain and snow showers before 2pm, then a slight chance of rain showers. Snow level 1100 feet. Partly sunny, with a high near 49. West northwest wind 6 to 10 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph. Chance of precipitation is 50%. Little or no snow accumulation expected. Saturday Night A 20 percent chance of showers before 11pm. Widespread frost, mainly after 1am. Snow level 1400 feet lowering to 900 feet after midnight. Otherwise, mostly clear, with a low around 31. Northwest wind 5 to 10 mph becoming light west northwest in the evening. Sunday Sunny, with a high near 56. Calm wind becoming north around 6 mph in the afternoon. Sunday Night Clear, with a low around 33. Monday Sunny, with a high near 62. Monday Night Clear, with a low around 37.

Remember to take regular breaks, do some stretching and maybe get a walk in.

Continued pursuit of answers from DOH ref: logistical and administrative requirements for assuming responsibility of vaccine.

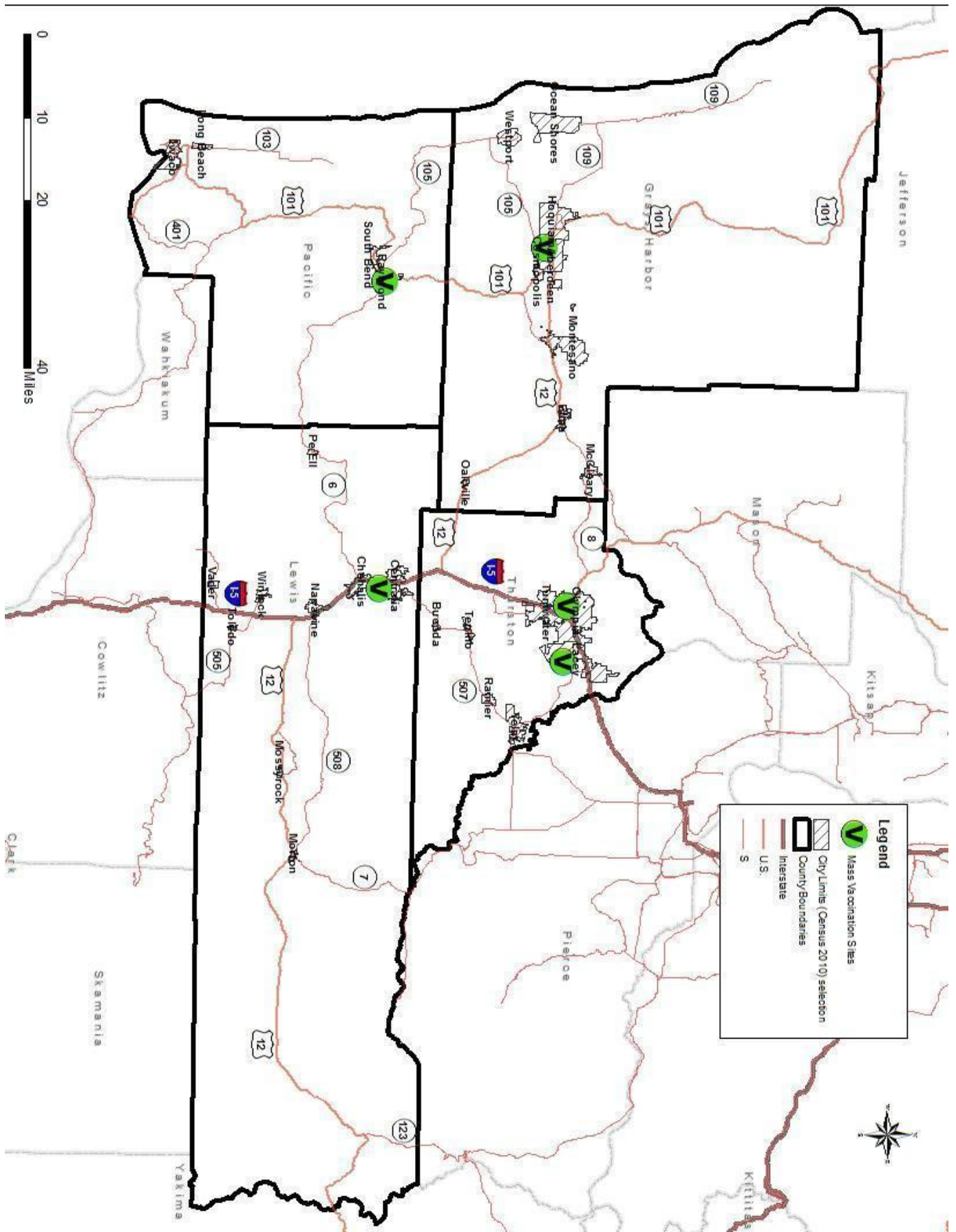
Safety completed the 215a for the Ocean Shores Convention Center POD.
