Starting Heat Perimeter used from NFIS Event Polygon data @ 0215 8/11/2021.

Janus: Heat perimeter continues to expand to the west and northwest. Intense heat areas are confined to the leading edge of the heat perimeter. A few smaller heat perimeters were added outside of the main heat perimeter. There is also heat perimeter increase on the southeastern edge with some intense heat. Scattered heat was observed throughout the heat perimeter. There are two isolated heat points outside of the northwestern edge of the heat perimeter.

Kola: Heat perimeter expanded modestly to the southeast. No noticeable intense heat, but scattered heat exists throughout the perimeter.
