Starting perimeters from NIFS features service, pulled at around @2000 PDT.

Janus: Heat perimeter continues to expand to the west and northwest. Intense heat areas are confined to the leading edge of the heat perimeter. There is also heat perimeter increase on the southern and southeastern edges with some intense heat. Scattered heat within the interior of the heat perimeter has dissipated. There are three new heat perimeters beyond the main heat perimeter: one on the south and two on the east. These also have observed intense heat.

Kola: Heat perimeter expanded modestl. No noticeable intense heat, but scattered heat exists throughout the perimeter.

Ridge: Heat perimeter showed slight growth; scattered heat is still present.
