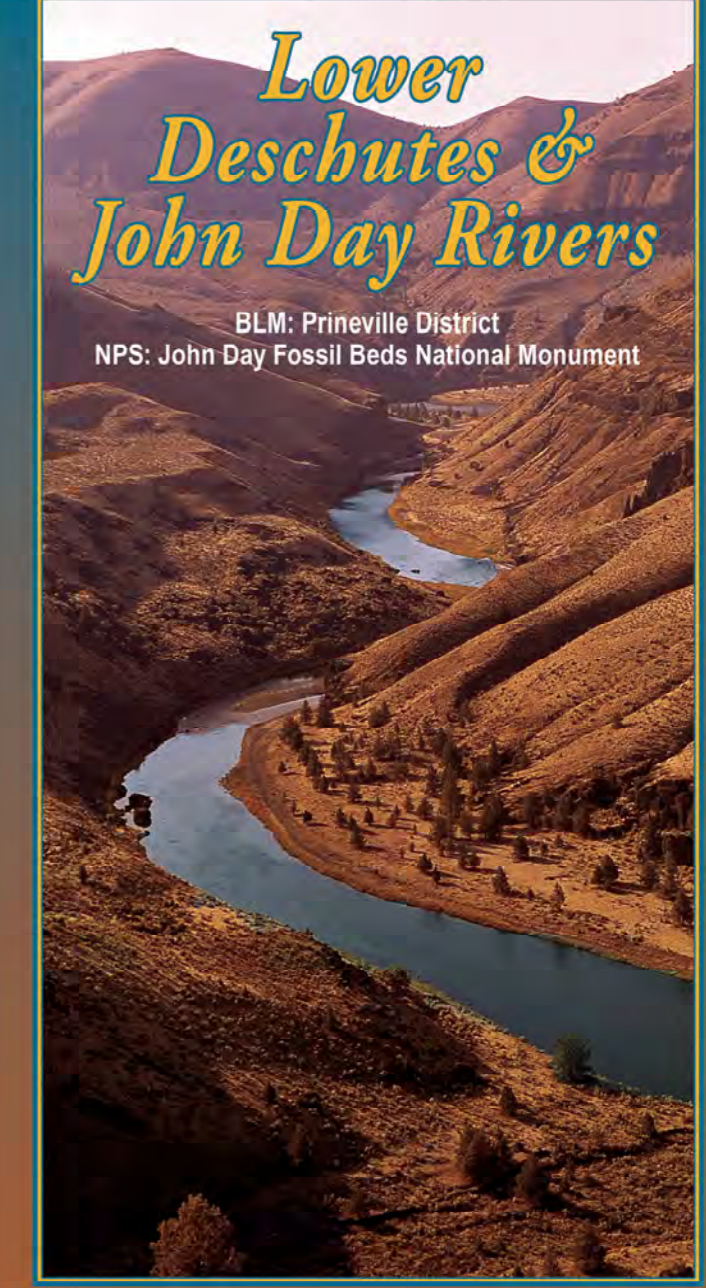

CHECK YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE USE MAP

The Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) is a site-specific map that shows the location and status of roads, trails, and areas where motor vehicles are prohibited. It is the responsibility of motor vehicle users to acquire the most current MVUM for the area they are traveling in. Motorist travel is restricted to designated roads, trails, and areas.
