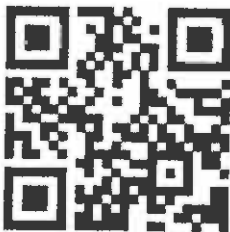



WEATHER DISCUSSION:

A front and upper level trough moved through overnight with an enhanced marine layer pushing into the Umpqua Basin with drizzle or a shower possible this morning. Much cooler temperatures are expected today with higher relative humidity values around the complex. A ridge is expected to build in behind the front with a return to warmer and drier conditions.

Fire Behavior Summary

GENERAL: Primary fuel types are TL5 and TU5. TL5 is comprised of conifer timber litter with jackpots of heavy dead/down materials. Primary surface fuels are duff and litter, larger branch wood, and grass and brush from previous fire activity. Slash units are scattered throughout the area. TU5 contains mixed conifer with timber litter, duff, timber and brush understory. Scattered hardwood stands are present throughout the area. Fuel density, continuity, aspect and exposure are key drivers of actual fire behavior.

Today's Fire Behavior

Fine fuel moisture will be in the 7-12% range. Expect moderate spread rates through the day if shaded or cloud cover, particularly in the grass fuel models, with activity through the late afternoon within thermal belt zones. Moderate fire behavior in the true fir fuel type with short runs aided by slope or wind. Rates of spread in the open timber will be steady with single and small group torching, producing spotting up to ¼ mile with a 40% probability of ignition.

Active backing and flanking, as well as roll out of burning material will produce short duration torching runs. Alignment of wind with topography will accelerate the spread potential and increase spotting distance. The grass and grass/brush fuel types will produce rapid spread with flame length potential to 5 feet in the afternoon. At moist site locations, the brush component can act as a heat sink.


Have lookouts who are taking weather obs calculate fine dead fuel moisture. There is a significant dropoff in rate of spread, flame lengths and ignition probability at the 10 and 11 breakpoint!!!

AIR OPERATIONS: Morning drizzle and subsequent water vapor are likely to impact morning ops.


SAFETY

Watch for small spot fires that may be hard to see in the morning if the humidity is high!

Resource Protection During Fire Suppression on U.S. Forest Service Land

Devils Knob Complex

Aquatics:

- Do not use fire-fighting foam, gel or other chemicals within 30 feet of streams or in any ponds or wetlands.
- Keep extra jerry cans for pumps at least 10 feet from stream channels and place them on absorbent pads to prevent fuel spills
- Draft/dip water only at approved designated sites. Do not reduce water below 1/3 of original streamflow or pond level unless approved by READ.
- Keep Aerial retardant 300 feet from any stream with water in it (use retardant avoidance maps)
- Do not cut through instream wood when building line.
- Use 3/32" screens when drafting in fish-bearing streams, READs have these if needed.
- If dip site known to have invasive species must be used, disinfect bucket before moving to different dip site.

Dozers:

- Stop dozer line 50' from live streams, finish with handline. No dozer line in wet areas, meadows or trails.
- If opening roads with dozer, identify and avoid culverts, push material to outside of road shoulder keeping material out of ditches.

Meadows, Cultural, Owls, Bridges:

- Do not drive vehicles into meadows; use low water pressure (no straight streaming) and no digging, in order to protect soils/plant bulbs; don't construct drop points, parking areas or safety zones; fall hazard trees away from mapped site location .
- Notify resource advisor if cultural resources are encountered. Leave all artifacts in place and provide GPS coordinates for locations.
- Avoid suppression activities in and around owl cores where possible.
- Review bridge permit requirements prior to transporting equipment over Forest bridges. *All equipment shall be transported by lowboy or trailer over bridges, no equipment walking.*

Personal Hygiene:

- Bury your business and paperwork a minimum of 6" deep, at least 200' from any water source.
- Do not introduce soap, shampoo or other chemicals into rivers, streams, or ponds/lakes.

If in doubt ask a READ, we are here to help you in fire suppression efforts while trying to minimize damage to resource values.

Major Hazards and Risks: SMOKE, POISON OAK, TRAFFIC ON HWY 227, DRIVING, HAZARD TREES, SAW OPERATIONS, STEEP TERRAIN, ROLLING MATERIAL, RUGGED ACCESS, CUMULATIVE FATIGUE, POISON OAK, ACTIVE FIRE

Hazard trees: They are common issues on the fireline where we work hard to keep up our situational awareness and mitigate those hazards.

Complacency and end of tour. For those coming to your end of tour, remember that a LOT of accidents and injuries happen in the final 30% of a tour +/- . Part of that happening is a result of getting complacent and/or comfortable with the hazards and risks of performing the job. The key is to be vigilant to the end.

New Assignment Requires Gaining Situation Awareness Both Day and Night: We are in transition between management teams and some are new to the incident or parts of the incident. Take a minute to orient yourself to the terrain, fuels, escape routes, safety zones, trigger points, travel routes, Communication Plan, Medical Incident Report and so on is PARAMOUNT TO A SAFE and EFFECTIVE OPERATION. If something doesn't look right or sound right, something is probably not quite right. LOOK AROUND and ASK QUESTIONS. Help those with the incoming team get up to speed. They need situational awareness too.

DRIVING is DANGEROUS. Use your best, courteous driving practices. It's all part of overall situation awareness.

Weather and Fire Behavior are giving you GOOD information. Consider it when both making and executing your plan. It's part and parcel to the Standard Firefighting Orders. Don't know which one(s)? Consult the IRPG.

A few words on mentoring. Remember that those in Senior positions either consciously or unconsciously set an example for the less experienced of us in Fire Mgt. While you may have enough insight concerning whatever to push the margins of safe work practice without a bad outcome, your junior member follows your example and without your insight, have the bad outcome. Point is help your less knowledgeable colleagues get up to speed by sharing your knowledge and training, a.k.a. *mentoring*. Set the good example by doing and demonstrating safe work practices.

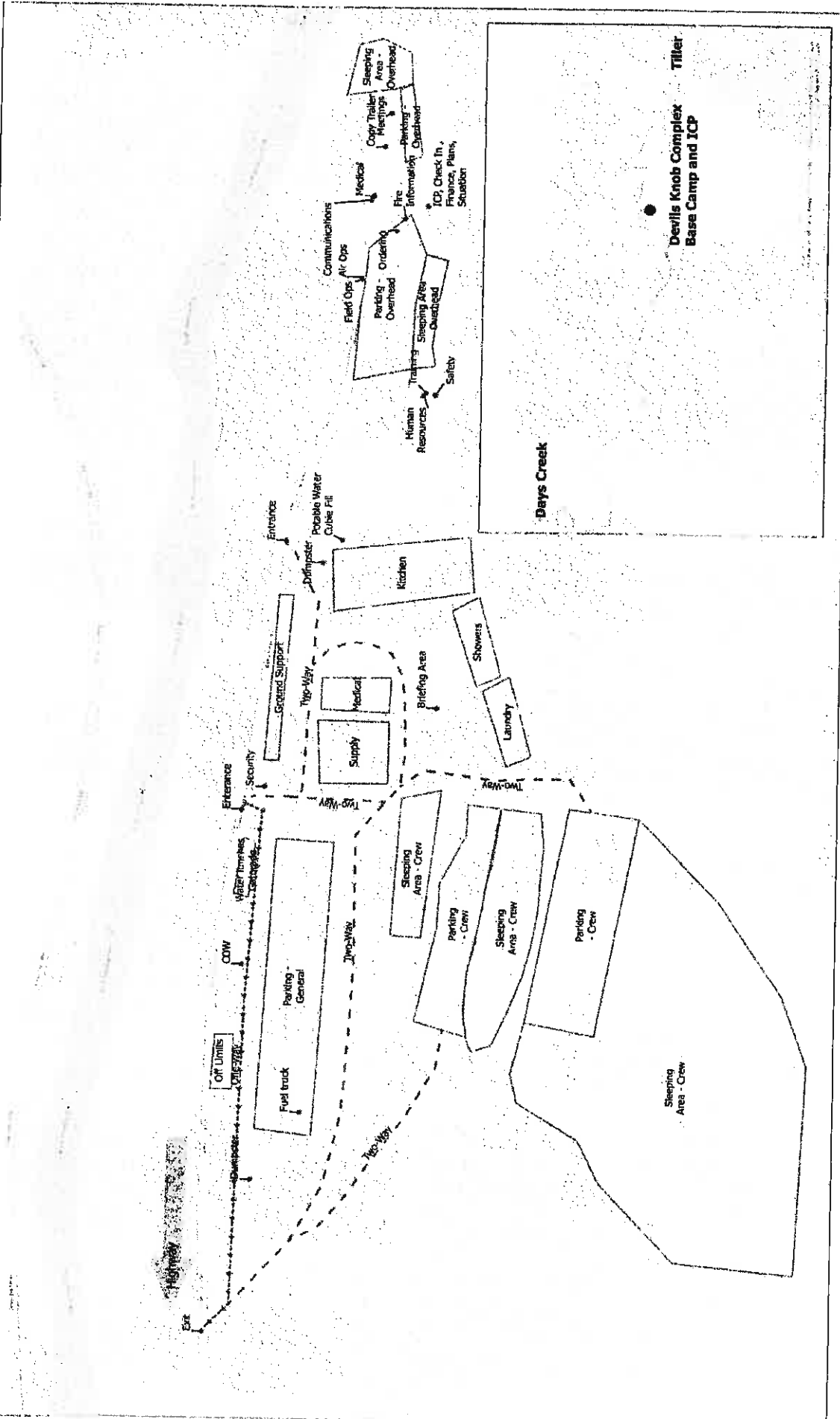

Leaders constantly assess the elements of the leadership environment and adapt accordingly. Successful leaders understand the interplay of these variables and demonstrate flexibility in selecting appropriate leadership tools and techniques as a situation changes.

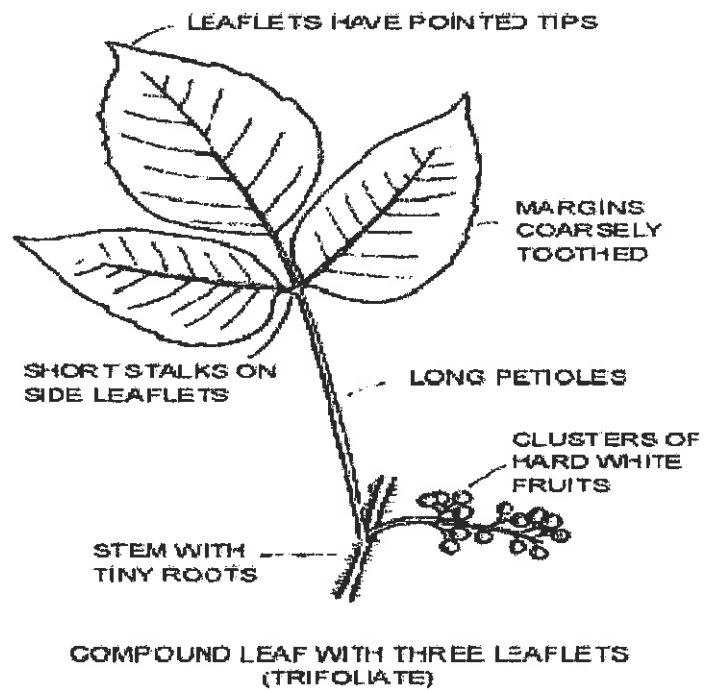
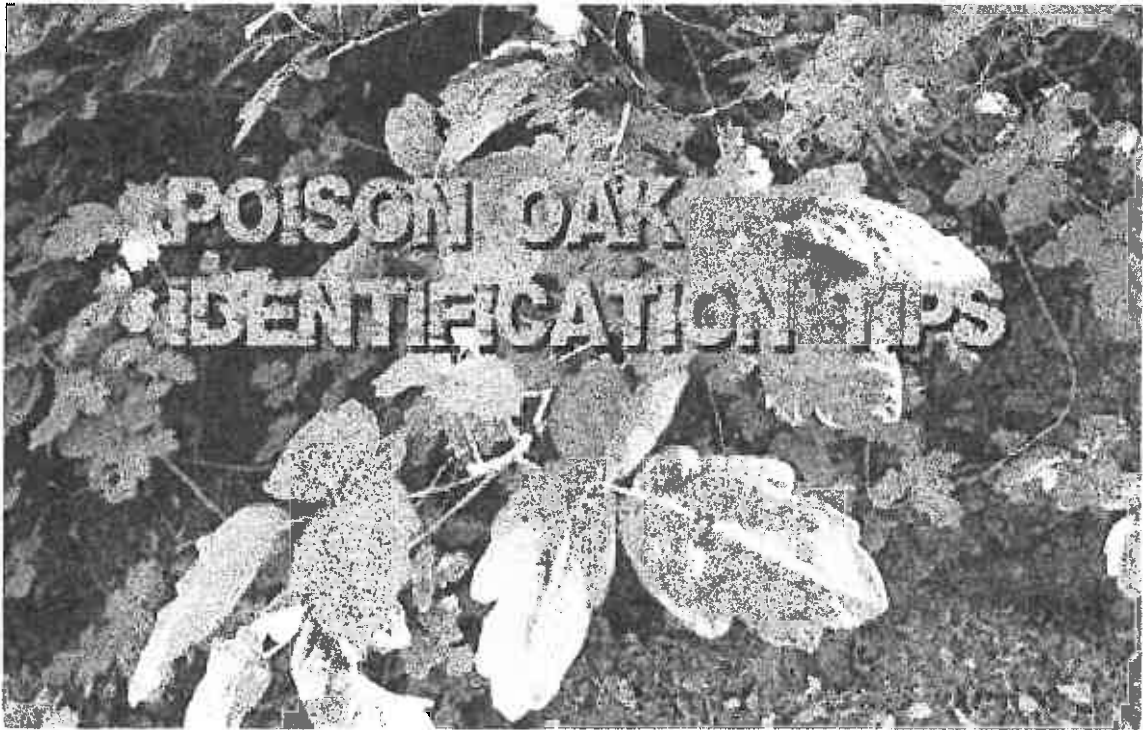

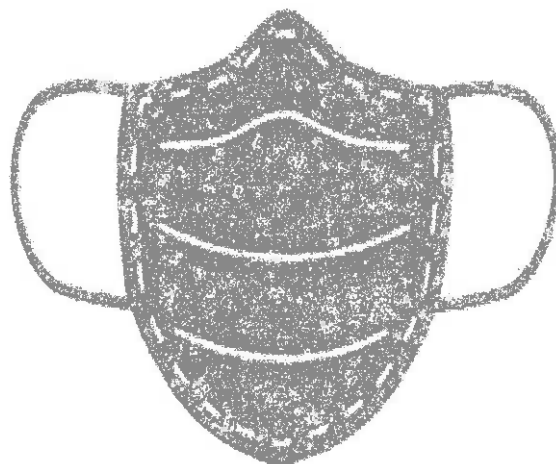
