## Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

## I began mapping from the NIFS fire perimeter.

The heat perimeter expanded by 1,330 acres; primarily in the western half of the fire. Some of the expansion looks as if it was due to burnout operations.

There remains abundant intense heat in the expansion zones as well as scattered and isolated heat throughout the remainder of the fire's interior
