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## **Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:**

Interpretation started with the current Wildfire Daily Perimeter in NIFS. Heat perimeter grew to the south, reaching Calf Creek. To the east the perimeter reached Dog Mountain and to the north it has crossed Redman Creek. Intense heat detected along the southern, northern and eastern perimeters. Spotting detected outside the perimeter to the east, in Dog Creek drainage and on Bradley Ridge near OR 138.
