## Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

A scan was performed for the Knoll incident scan box, however, no heat was detected within the scan box. It appears as though the scan box was put in for a location that does not correspond with location of the Knoll TFR. Fires include:

Gales: growth was mapped on all sides of the fire, but was most pronounced to the east. The fire has reached the top of Gold Point and is established east of this point. Areas of growth showed intense and scattered heat along the fire's edge. Kwis: The Kwis fire grew to the south, with a large pocket of intense heat as well as two disconnected spot fires located south Salmon Falls. Scattered heat was found in much of the rest of the fire area.

Ninemile: Limited growth was mapped, and no intense heat was detected on the Ninemile fire. Most of the fire area continues to show scattered heat.
