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Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Fires include:

Gales: Perimeter growth was mapped in the northwestern, northeastern and southeastern portions of the fire with intense heat mapped along all leading edges of the fire. The Fire's interior continues to hold scattered heat.

Kwis: Fire growth was mapped along the fire's southern edge, with intense heat associated with areas of growth. All mapped heat remains between Salmon Creek and FSroad 5871. An active firing operation was evident along FS road 5871 in the fire's southeastern corner. A handful of isolated heat sources were identified between the main fire and this road. Ninemile: Very little growth was mapped, with much of the fire area holding scattered heat.
