Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Mapping used the incident provided event polygon as a base for mapping. Fires include: Gales: Limited growth was mapped since the previous night's IR. Areas of perimeter growth continue to hold intense heat along the fires leading edge. Kwis: Growth continues to the south. The burnout along the fire's southeastern edge was evident in tonight's imagery. Ninemile: Limited growth this period.
