Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Mapping used the incident's event polygon as a base for mapping.

Fires include:

Gales: An active burnout operation was observed along FS 210 southwest of the main Gales fire near the Div Y / Div W division break.

Kwis: Some fire growth was mapped on the fire's southwestern. The unburned island in the fire's southeastern corner has nearly filled in. Once again tonight a potential heat source was detected along the railroad tracks south of the fire. This potential heat source is near, but not at the same location as yesterday's potential heat source.

Ninemile: Limited growth was mapped for ninemile today.
