Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: Interpretation started with the current Wildfire Daily Perimeter in NIFS. Reported acres are geodesic. Kwis: No change in perimeter. No heat outside of the perimeter. Gales: Growth in perimeter primarily along southern perimeter and in Tiller Creek watershed. Two spot fires detected outside the perimeter. One is 0.5 miles south of perimeter in Perdue Creek basin and one is 1 mile south of the perimeter in Delp Creek basin.
