## **Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:**

Tonight's mapping used the previous nights IR as a base for mapping.

Chaos Fire: 1262 acres (+172) perimeter growth was primarily limited to the northeastern and southwestern corners of the fire. To the north, the fire has now crossed the unnamed drainage and established at the bottom of the south facing slope below Canton Point.

Little Bend Creek 592 acres (+204) Growth was primarily mapped on the south end of the fire, extending across Homestead Ridge and towards Fireman's Leap. A new disconnected heat polygon was detected just southeast of the main fire, on the opposite side of FS Road 250.
