## Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

\*\*Note: at the request of the IMT managing the fire, this log also includes the acres calculated for the fires south of Jack including the fires near Mink Creek, Buckhorn Mountain and Snowbird Mountain.

Tonight's mapping used the previous nights IR as a base for mapping.

Chaos Fire: 1473 acres (+211)

Little Bend Creek: Unable to map due to weather. This scan box was UTF for weather.

Tonight's IR work included the fires south of Jack. Of these fires, the one just north of Mink Creek was the most active progressing to the east ½ mile since the last flight. Areas of perimeter growth on this fire were mapped as intense heat. The mappable heat remains north of Mink Creek.
