Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: **Note: at the request of the IMT managing the fire, tonight's acreage includes only the acres associated with the Jack fire. For acres associated with the fires south of Jack including the fires near Mink Creek, Buckhorn Mountain and Snowbird Mountain, see the maps and logs for the Rough Patch Complex (https://ftp.wildfire.gov/public/incident_specific_data/pacific_nw/2021_Incidents_Oregon/2021_RoughPatchCpx_ORUMP000373/IR/) Very little perimeter growth was mapped again today. However, activity on Rough Patch fires just south of jack continues. Jack is now within 1/10 th miles from it's Rough Patch Complex neighbor to the south.
