**DISCUSSION** Relatively quiet pattern in store beginning this weekend, extending into much of next week. Weather pattern characterized by primarily westerly flow aloft, resulting in seasonable temperatures, mostly clear conditions, and relatively light winds. No real sensible weather impacts expected through at least Wednesday next week. Could see light breeziness on Wednesday, but thus far any impacts look to be minimal.

### CORONAVIRUS SAFETY
