### ...Red Flag Warning in Effect This Afternoon and Evening for Thunderstorms... ...Heavy Rain and Gusty/Erratic Winds Possible with Thunderstorms...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: A change in the weather pattern has begun due to a Pacific low pressure system moving closer towards the coast and will rotate bands of moisture across eastern Washington and eastern Oregon. The air mass is already unstable, and showers and thunderstorms over eastern Oregon during the afternoon will approach southeast Washington late this afternoon and overnight. Some storms may bring heavy downpours this weekend. Outflow winds up to 35 mph are possible. A cooling trend with increasing humidity also begins today with significant improvement on Sunday.

### **TODAY:**

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy. A chance of afternoon showers or thunderstorms after 1600.

MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE: 80-85° above 5000 feet. 92-97° valley bottoms.

MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY: 22-27% above 5000 feet. 18-22% valley bottoms.

20-FOOT RIDGETOP WINDS: East 5-10 mph becoming West 5-10 mph gusting to 12-15 mph.

GREEN RIDGE CREEKS: Upslope/Upcanyon 3-8 mph.

### **FUELS:**

Fire areas include a range of conifer systems, from higher elevation Sub Alpine Fir and Engelmann Spruce, to Doug-Fir, Grand Fir and Lodgepole Pine under 5000', and Ponderosa Pine in the lower elevations of the Forest. Outside of the 2006 Columbia Complex and the 2015 Grizzly Complex, all forested areas have extensive dead and down and ladder fuels that will work together to elevate fire into the crowns and generate short range spotting.

The area is currently classified as 'Exceptional' drought by the US Drought Monitor, with Energy Release Components currently setting daily record highs, and approaching all time high levels. You may see some resistance to spread in brush and re-prod areas, but these veg structures are losing moisture daily. Heavy dead and down fuels will likely burn completely, holding heat and actively consuming through all hours of the day.

### **GENERAL/Potential:**

**DAY:** Fire spread, spotting distances, and flame lengths have been highly variable across the fire area and dependent on recent burn scars, exposure to wind, and terrain. Clearing skies and ventilation, even for short durations, can greatly escalate fire spread to a slope driven run and send spots into the next drainage downwind. Heavies are highly receptive to spotting; live foliar moisture is low enough to support torching single and dense clusters of timber.

### **SPECIFIC**

**Green Ridge**: Fire will continue to rollout, flank and run upslope within the Tucannon River drainage near H34. Spot fires have become more established in the SE corner of the fire and continue to do the same, especially outside of the 2006 Columba Complex fire scars. West Butte and Oregon Butte will see more torching and slope runs, with embers across the line a continued possibility. Morning winds may support spotting across Friday's burnout operations. Be especially heads up for any outflow winds that will snake through terrain and cause rapid escalation of fire activity across the fire area.

**Lick Creek:** Down but not out. Interior pockets continue to move around and may find single trees or clusters to torch out and spot with wind support across lines.

### **AIR OPERATIONS:**

Sunrise: 0531, Civil Twilight ends: 2058

### SAFETY:

Red Flag Warning in effect from 1200-2400 for abundant dry lightning and gusty outflow winds. Downdrafts in the vicinity will be highly influenced by terrain; quiet areas of the fire may rapidly escalate with strong winds.

### **Driving**

- When driving, reduce speed according to road conditions (loose gravel, wet, muddy). Remember you are getting paid to drive slowly!
- DRIVE DEFENSIVELY......lights on.... WATCH OUT FOR THE OTHER'S. Reports of UTV traffic on the roadways "In Division A/G, K".
- Deer like to come out at the dusk hours right when its time to turn in.

**COMPLACENCY:** This incident still has potential to injure you and change your life forever. **Maintain your Situational Awareness!** 

### **FireLine**

- Burnout plan relayed to all resources involved.
- Rotate crews out of Smokey areas, give them some clean air.
- If you are holding/resting on the line/road DON'T LAY IN THE ROAD.

Firefighters do experience short-term effects of smoke, such as stinging, watery eyes, coughing and runny noses. Firefighters must be in good physical condition which helps to offset adverse effects from smoke.

• When finding your sleeping areas "Look Up Look Down Look Around", is there hazards that may affect your sleeping area.

SUBJECT: MPHAT Wildland Fire COVID-19 Prevention and Mitigation 2021

The purpose of this memorandum is to request wide distribution of the attached *Wildland Fire COVID-19 Prevention and Mitigation 2021* guidance issued from the Medical and Public Advisory Team (MPHAT) July 17, 2021.

The following has been excerpted as recommendations for fire leadership.

- Fire managers, agency administrators, line officers and incident managers need to re-enforce the importance of prevention and mitigation of COVID-19 in the workplace.
  - MPHAT would like to remind all leadership and fire personnel that following MPHAT's guidance has been proven effective and is critical to prevent the further spread of COVID-19.
  - Leader's intent and expectations must be clear that COVID-19 prevention and mitigation is still a priority for the 2021 fire season.
  - With vaccination status not being systematically tracked, face covering/mask and physical distancing requirements on wildfire incidents needs strengthened everyone follow COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for un-vaccinated individuals regarding physical distancing and mask/face covering use in fire camp unless alone in an enclosed space or actively engaged in firefighting on the fireline.
- Fire managers, agency administrators, line officers and incident managers need to prioritize and incorporate COVID-19 strategies that were effective and considered standard operating procedures in 2020 such as:
  - o daily individual screening tool, distributive operations, spike camps, boxed meals, community cooler mitigations, remote briefings, decentralized staging areas, virtual and remote participation, and module as one (updated) to the maximum extent possible.







# Base Camp Facilities Map






One Way Route
