#### **OUTPUTS FIRE BEHAVIOR**

GENERAL: Fire behavior should be much less intense today with the lower wind speeds. Moderate humidity combined with the lower wind speeds will result in slower rates of speed, reduced torching, and a lower chance of crown fire.

Probability of ignition is 65% with spotting distances of 1000 feet possible. Haines Index 3

1-hour fuel moistures: 5%, 10 hours at 5%, 100 hours at 7%, 1000-hour fuels are  $\sim$ 8 % and live fuel moistures are at around 75-95%. ERCs are above the  $97^{th}$  percentile.

#### SPECIFIC:

Green Ridge: The fire will continue to progress up and out of the drainages, but should lessened with the NNW winds. Expect this pattern to continue throughout the day and into the late evening, although the runs will be not be as active as we've seen the last few days. Rates of spread will be slower and flame lengths reduced. The fire may be active in the heavier concentrations of fuels as the winds surface. Conditions should be favorable for burnout operations in Division M.

Lick Creek: The north/northwest winds today should again be favorable by pushing the heat and smoke into the interior.

Night Division: Due to the late burning periods, anticipate daytime burning conditions to continue well into the late evening and continuing until the downslope winds set up and/or the humidity recovers.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

Heavy smoke may hamper air operations.

- Do not let a sense of urgency, or the hazardous mindsets of "impulsiveness" or "mission fixation" compromise your safety.
- It takes whatever amount of time it takes, to do it safely.
- Any time spent planning for safety will pay dividends in the end. Use the PACE model when developing this plan:
  - Primary: What are the strategies and tactics you will utilize to accomplish your assigned mission/task?
  - Alternate: What are you going to do if your primary plan is not meeting objectives, or conditions have changed to where it is no longer safe? Can different strategies and tactics be utilized to accomplish the same objectives? Would different equipment or tools be more effective?
  - Contingency: Primary and alternate plans have failed. Conditions have changed drastically, and the plan needs to be re-evaluated. Available and ordered resources will be insufficient to accomplish the mission. It may no longer be safe to be in the area. Consider withdrawal to safer location to evaluate and discuss the new situation.
  - Emergency: It is time to GO. Utilize pre-identified escape routes to safety zones. Consistently evaluate these routes and areas to determine efficacy as conditions (time, fatigue, terrain, weather, fire behavior, etc.) change.

Avoid becoming so attached to your plan that you are unwilling to change. Identify and communicate trigger points.
