## ...Flash Flood Watch in effect through This Evening... ... Heavy Rain and Gusty/Erratic Winds Possible with Thunderstorms...

WEATHER DISCUSSION: Showers and thunderstorms this morning will taper off, but lingering moisture and instability will bring a chance of showers and thunderstorms in the afternoon and evening. Any storms that develop will be slow moving and capable of bringing heavy downpours. This could cause erosion of slopes with rock slides and debris flows in the steep canyons. It will be considerably cooler with higher humidity today.

## TODAY:

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy. Showers likely and a chance of thunderstorms, mainly in the morning.

MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE: 70-75° above 5000 feet. 80-85° valley bottoms.

MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY: 58-65% above 5000 feet. 30-35% valley bottoms.

### **FUELS:**

Fire areas include a range of conifer systems, from higher elevation Sub Alpine Fir and Engelmann Spruce, to Doug-Fir, Grand Fir and Lodgepole Pine under 5000', and Ponderosa Pine in the lower elevations of the Forest. Outside of the 2006 Columbia Complex and the 2015 Grizzly Complex, all forested areas have extensive dead and down and ladder fuels that will work together to elevate fire into the crowns and generate short range spotting.

The area is currently classified as 'Exceptional' drought by the US Drought Monitor, with Energy Release Components currently setting daily record highs, and approaching all time high levels. You may see some resistance to spread in brush and re-prod areas, but these veg structures are losing moisture daily. Heavy dead and down fuels will likely burn completely, holding heat and actively consuming through all hours of the day.

## **GENERAL/Potential:**

**DAY:** Moisture will bring a short-term moderation to fire spread today. Heavy dead fuels need substantial, long duration moisture for them to begin their recover from record lows. With any afternoon clearing we could still see a short window of isolated torching of single trees and some ember production that could find a home in punky logs.

## **SPECIFIC**

**Green Ridge**: Areas holding the most heat include the Turkey Tail Ridge and Meadow Creek areas, as well as the fire edge in the vicinity of West Butte. Can't rule out some roll out in the steepest areas near H-34, H-44, or out in the rugged country along the SE flank of the fire.

Lick Creek: Down but not out. Interior pockets continue to move around and may find single trees or clusters to torch out and spot with wind support across lines. Heads up for any torching or rollout within Saturday's spot fire area near H-16, as the edge drops off to steep, hard to access country very quickly.

SUBJECT: MPHAT Wildland Fire COVID-19 Prevention and Mitigation 2021

The purpose of this memorandum is to request wide distribution of the attached Wildland Fire COVID-19 Prevention and Mitigation 2021 guidance issued from the Medical and Public Advisory Team (MPHAT) July 17, 2021.

The following has been excerpted as recommendations for fire leadership.

- Fire managers, agency administrators, line officers and incident managers need to re-enforce the importance of prevention and mitigation of COVID-19 in the workplace.
  - o MPHAT would like to remind all leadership and fire personnel that following MPHAT's guidance has been proven effective and is critical to prevent the further spread of COVID-19.
  - o Leader's intent and expectations must be clear that COVID-19 prevention and mitigation is still a priority for the 2021 fire season.
  - With vaccination status not being systematically tracked, face covering/mask and physical distancing requirements on wildfire incidents needs strengthened – everyone follow COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for un-vaccinated individuals regarding physical distancing and mask/face covering use in fire camp unless alone in an enclosed space or actively engaged in firefighting on the fireline.
- Fire managers, agency administrators, line officers and incident managers need to prioritize and incorporate COVID-19 strategies that were effective and considered standard operating procedures in 2020 such as:
  - o daily individual screening tool, distributive operations, spike camps, boxed meals, community cooler mitigations, remote briefings, decentralized staging areas, virtual and remote participation, and module as one (updated) to the maximum extent possible.






