## ... Returning to Much Warmer Temperatures with Low Humidity the Next Several Days...

<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION</u>: It will be very warm today with a considerable drop in the relative humidity compared to yesterday. The air mass will be relatively stable with a light northwest wind. Expect even warmer temperatures with low humidity on Tuesday.

## **TODAY:**

WEATHER: Decreasing clouds. Becoming partly cloudy.

MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE: 72-77° above 5000 feet. 83-88° valley bottoms.

MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY: 50-55% above 5000 feet. 30-35% valley bottoms.

20-FOOT RIDGETOP WINDS: Northwest 4-8 mph.

## **FUELS:**

Fire areas include a range of conifer systems, from higher elevation Sub Alpine Fir and Engelmann Spruce, to Doug-Fir, Grand Fir and Lodgepole Pine under 5000', and Ponderosa Pine in the lower elevations of the Forest. Outside of the 2006 Columbia Complex and the 2015 Grizzly Complex, all forested areas have extensive dead and down and ladder fuels that will work together to elevate fire into the crowns and generate short range spotting.

The area is currently classified as 'Exceptional' drought by the US Drought Monitor, with Energy Release Components currently setting daily record highs, and approaching all time high levels. You may see some resistance to spread in brush and re-prod areas, but these veg structures are losing moisture daily. Heavy dead and down fuels will likely burn completely, holding heat and actively consuming through all hours of the day.

## **GENERAL/Potential:**

**DAY:** Gradual warming and drying into the middle of the week, tracking towards another Haines of 5 for instability and dryness on Wednesday. Yesterday's rainfall will have little impact on fire spread today, as the heavies will need long duration wetting rains to end the local fire season. By afternoon we should see a return to single and group tree torching, spotting and rollout.

## **SPECIFIC**

**Green Ridge**: Fire has backed to within 300 yards of the Ladybug Campground in Division K/M; this area received little rainfall yesterday. Anticipate spread down slope and more flanking fire off to the east within the Tucannon River drainage. Divisions A/G/P/S did receive some moisture on Sunday, however we will see a return to the spotting/torching spread model by late afternoon. Slope runs could increase rates of spread and downwind spotting distances.

Lick Creek: Low probability, high consequence spotting concerns remain along the western and southern flanks.

**Night Division:** Activity will slowly taper down from shift change across the active parts of the Green Ridge fire as the smoke settles and relative humidity recovers.

## **AIR OPERATIONS:**

Sunrise: 0532, Civil Twilight ends: 2056

## SAFETY:

Fire behavior can quickly transition to smoldering in heavies to single to group torching and long-range spotting.

Communicate changes in activity and ensure LCES is in place.

## **Working With Helicopters**

Always follow instructions from helitack crew when working around Helibase or Helispots. Never approach Helicopters without direction from Helicopter personnel or the pilot. Do not perform any helicopter operations you are not qualified for. Stay clear when Helicopters are doing bucket drops.

On your IRPG front cover you will find the upside-down clock as a guide to help you when talking to the pilot and guiding them into a particular area. The Pilot is always flying in the 12 o'clock direction

The IRPG as other aviation tools in the blue pg. 45-63

Reminders: We need to be wearing our appropriate PPE while on the fire line. Please don't feed the wild life you remaining LUNCH & pack out all Garbage.

## **Morale**

> Is the capacity of a group's members to maintain belief in an institution or goal, particularly in the face of opposition or hardship.

Night Operations - Have a purpose for what you are doing and minimize the exposure. Approach and complete all operations in a slow and methodical manner. Pace yourselves.

Communications: Review with your module in the event you have to a medical emergency that requires helicopter flight what are your actions going to be to get the patient to the needed location for medical attention.

**Drought Conditions:** Pay close attention to the burning conditions. The fuel bed is much more receptive to fire and spotting. Fires will go from a mere spot to a dangerous situation very quickly. You won't need winds for rapid fire growth. Preplan "what if" situations.

## FREQUENT SPOT FIRES ACROSS THE LINE

- Can you handle increased spotting? List some ways you can keep ahead of spot fires (gridding the green, lookouts, etc.)
- What is your probability of ignition doing? Is it increasing or decreasing?
- Do you have a plan for long-range spotting? In what fuel type and under what conditions will you likely have longrange spotting? What types of plans can you think of for handling long-range spotting?
- Is help available if necessary? What kinds of resources will you have in place or order to handle spot fires?
- If fire behavior increases, is your position still defensible? Discuss what type of action you might take if a spot fire takes off.
- Do you have more than one safety zone in case one gets cut off? Describe how you might have multiple safety
- Do the primary lookouts have a good view of the situation? Discuss who might be acting as a lookout (e.g., crew member, air resources, etc.) and how you will get good information from that person. (Are you relying on an air attack that is busy with air tankers?)
- Where are you in the burning period? Talk about how your tactics may vary from finding spot fires early in the day to later into the evening. Review Probability of Ignition (PIG) and what it can tell you about spotting potential.

To reduce the risk, be ready to retreat. Keep your guard up even if spotting has not occurred for a few hours. Review fires where you have had frequent spot fires and what you learned about controlling them.

SUBJECT: MPHAT Wildland Fire COVID-19 Prevention and Mitigation 2021

The purpose of this memorandum is to request wide distribution of the attached *Wildland Fire COVID-19 Prevention and Mitigation 2021* guidance issued from the Medical and Public Advisory Team (MPHAT) July 22, 2021.

The following has been excerpted as recommendations for fire leadership.

- Fire managers, agency administrators, line officers and incident managers need to re-enforce the importance of prevention and mitigation of COVID-19 in the workplace.
  - MPHAT would like to remind all leadership and fire personnel that following MPHAT's guidance has been proven effective and is critical to prevent the further spread of COVID-19.
  - Leader's intent and expectations must be clear that COVID-19 prevention and mitigation is still a priority for the 2021 fire season.
  - With vaccination status not being systematically tracked, face covering/mask and physical distancing requirements on wildfire incidents needs to be strengthened. It is recommended that everyone follow COVID-19 prevention and mitigation guidance for un-vaccinated individuals regarding physical distancing and mask/face covering use in fire camp, unless outdoors and able to maintain at least 6ft of distance at all times, alone in an enclosed space or actively engaged in firefighting on the fireline.
- Fire managers, agency administrators, line officers and incident managers need to prioritize and incorporate COVID-19 strategies that were effective and considered standard operating procedures in 2020 such as:
  - o daily individual screening tool, distributive operations, spike camps, boxed meals, community cooler mitigations, remote briefings, decentralized staging areas, virtual and remote participation, and module as one (updated) to the maximum extent possible.






