Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Interpretation started with the current IR heat perimeter in NIFS. Perimeter has grown to the south and west, approaching Patcha Creek and Buckley Ridge. Intense heat in these areas with isolated heat sources detected outside of the perimeter. Scan did not cover the far north of the perimeter, Rubenser Ridge. This is identified on the maps. Scan box may need to be adjusted.
